

TO THE HONORABLE SINGLETON BELL, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT  
OF QUARTER SESSION OF CLEARFIELD COUNTY.

The petition of the undersigned, Supervisors of Bradford  
township respectfully represents :

FIRST. That a part of the public road in said township  
known as the Pearce road, and which extends from a point near the  
village of Bigler to a point at, or near the Pearce farm, your  
petitioners believe it advisable to change or alter, for a distance  
of five hundred fifty (550) feet, and by said change to remove from  
said road a steep hill and thus render said road much better for  
travel by the public.

SECOND. That the cost and expense of said change, includ-  
ing damages to the land owners will not exceed three hundred  
dollars (\$300).

THIRD. That your petitioners have agreed with the proper-  
ty owners, whose land which said change of road passes, as to  
damages.

FOURTH. That your petitioners hereto attach a draft or  
blue-print showing the proposed change.


Your petitioners therefore pray the court that the new  
location be approved and shall be taken and deemed to be the public  
road ~~to~~ all intents and purposes, and the old location shall be  
taken and deemed to be vacated, without the formality of a view, as


