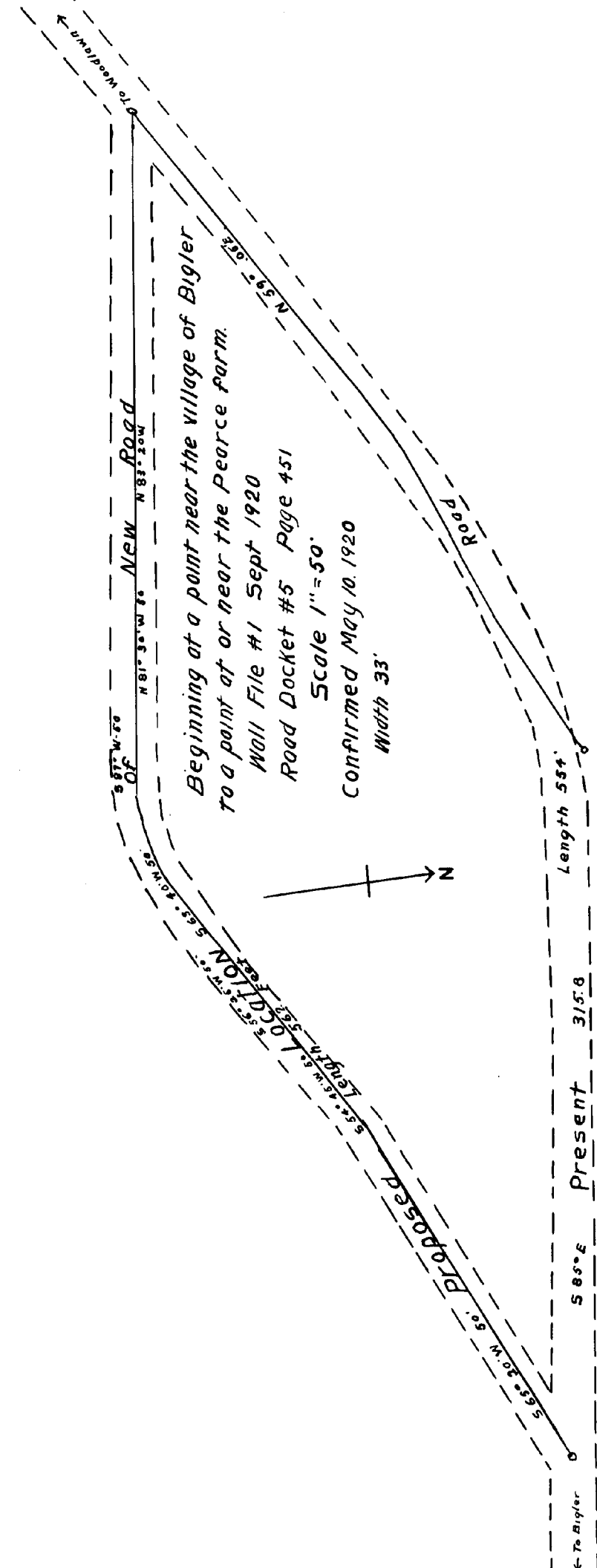

TO THE HONORABLE SINGLETON BELL, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT  
OF QUARTER SESSION OF CLEARFIELD COUNTY.

The petition of the undersigned, Supervisors of Bradford township respectfully represents :

FIRST. That a part of the public road in said township known as the Pearce road, and which extends from a point near the village of Bigler to a point at, or near the Pearce farm, your petitioners believe it advisable to change or alter, for a distance of five hundred fifty (550) feet, and by said change to remove from said road a steep hill and thus render said road much better for travel by the public.

SECOND. That the cost and expense of said change, including damages to the land owners will not exceed three hundred dollars(\$300).

THIRD. That your petitioners have agreed with the property owners, whose land which said change of road passes, as to damages.

FOURTH. That your petitioners hereto attach a draft or blue-print showing the proposed change.

Your petitioners therefore pray the court that the new location be approved and shall be taken and deemed to be the public road ~~to~~ all intents and purposes, and the old location shall be taken and deemed to be vacated, without the formality of a view, as prescribed by Act of Assembly, and they will ever pray, oc.
