no longer used for travel, is impassable and expensive to maintain.

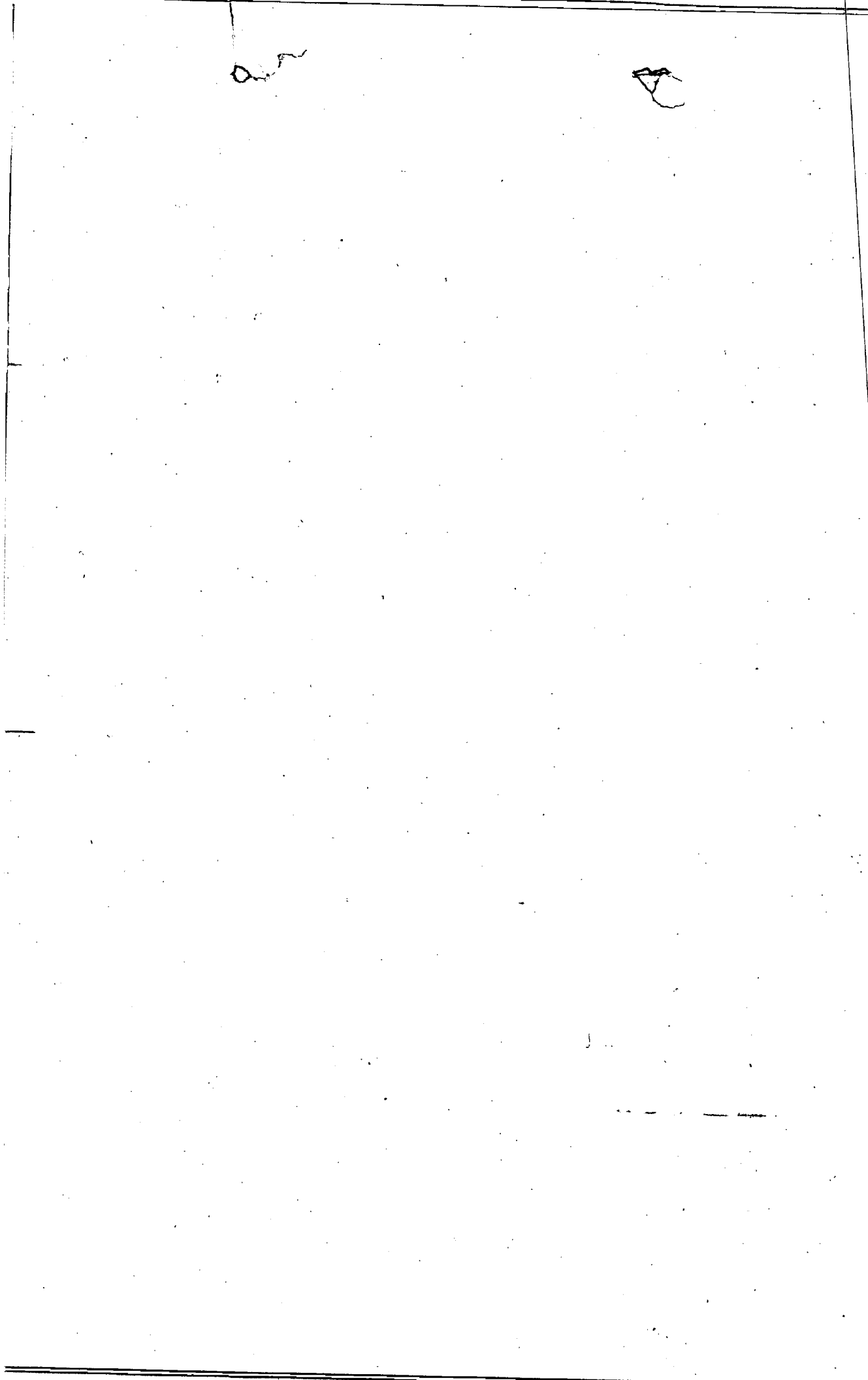
Your petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint Viewers

RETURN OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGE OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF THE PEACE, IN AND FOR THE
COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD, PA.

We, the undersigned Viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, beg leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of the view and of the hearing day was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County, and the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Knox -----, and that three (3), ----- notices thereof were posted along the route of the said road to be vacated, that the said view would be held on the

30th day of June (th 30),, A. D. 1920, and that the public hearing, as required by the Act of Assembly, and the Rules of Court, would be held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House, in Clearfield,

Pa., on the first day of July A. D., 1920, at 9,30 o'clock A.M., and that said Viewers, appointed by the said order, viewed the road desired to be vacated, and that there were present at the view besides the viewers Curtis W Snyder and Dr E S Erhard two of the Supervisors of Knox Township and John Snyder a property holder along the route of said road to be vacated; -----

parties interested, either in favor of or against vacating said road. And that the aforesaid hearing was held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the first day of July -----,

A. D. 1920, when the parties interested in the said road were in attendance: to wit: Curtis W Snyder one of the Supervisors of said Township, -----

And that after the view and hearing above mentioned, the undersigned Viewers do agree that said road has -----, become useless, inconvenient and burdensome and therefore recommend that

same be vacated as prayed for in the said petition to wit:

Beginning at a point or intersection of said road, with the Public road leading from Boardman to New-Millport about one fourth mile west of the residence of Isaac Rea; thence running south fifty one (51) degrees, forty five (45) minutes west, one thousand nine hundred and eighty seven (1987), feet over land of John Snyder, Thence over land of the Carnwath Coal Company the following courses and distances: south sixty four (64), degrees, fifteen (15) minutes west, one hundred (100) feet; thence south seventy two (72), degrees forty five (45), minutes, west five hundred (500), feet; thence south eighty (80), degrees, west, two hundred (200) feet; thence south eighty nine (89), degrees, west across the coal plane of the Carnwath coal Company six hundred (600) feet thence south eighty six (86) degrees, west, two hundred (200) feet; thence south, seventy five (75) degrees, west, one hundred (100) feet; thence south forty five (45) degrees, thirty minutes (30) west one hundred (100) feet; thence south thirty three (33) degrees, west three hundred (300) feet; thence south twenty two (22) degrees, thirty (30) minutes

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, Pa., held at Clearfield, Pa., in and for said County, on the **Tenth (10th)** day of **May**, ----- in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and **twenty (20)** -----


By the Honorable Singleton Bell, President Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the Township of **Knox**, -----, in the County aforesaid setting forth that **a certain public road about one mile in length, in said Township; Beginning at a point or intersection of said road with the public road leading from Boardman to New-Millport, about one fourth of a mile west of the residence of Isaac Rea; and connecting with the public road, leading from the Oak Ridge School House and church to Carnwath, is no longer used for travel and is impassible and expensive to keep up;** -----

and, therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate said road between the points mentioned, whereupon the said Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint from and among the County Board of Viewers **A. G. Kramer Esq. E. D. Billotte and**

J. S. Michaels ----- who have been duly appointed by the said Court on the County Board of Viewers, and filed their oaths of office in the office of the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid, as required by law and are, therefore, duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment, with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment; are to view the said road, and after having viewed the same, if they, or a majority of them, do agree that there is no necessity for said road, they shall proceed to vacate the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, and make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in and for said County, stating particularly whether there is any necessity for said road, or whether the same should be vacated; and the reason why, together with a plot, or draft, thereof showing the courses and distances with reference to the improvements through which said road passes.

And in case the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating said road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road passes, or otherwise affected, or damaged, by the vacating of said road, releases from whatever damage they may sustain by the vacation of said road; and in case the owners of such lands, or persons affected, thereby refuse to release their claim to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the same, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages, arising from the vacation of said road; and make report of such assessment; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft, or plot, aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn, or affirmed, according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when and the place where they would meet, to view said road and the time and place of hearing.

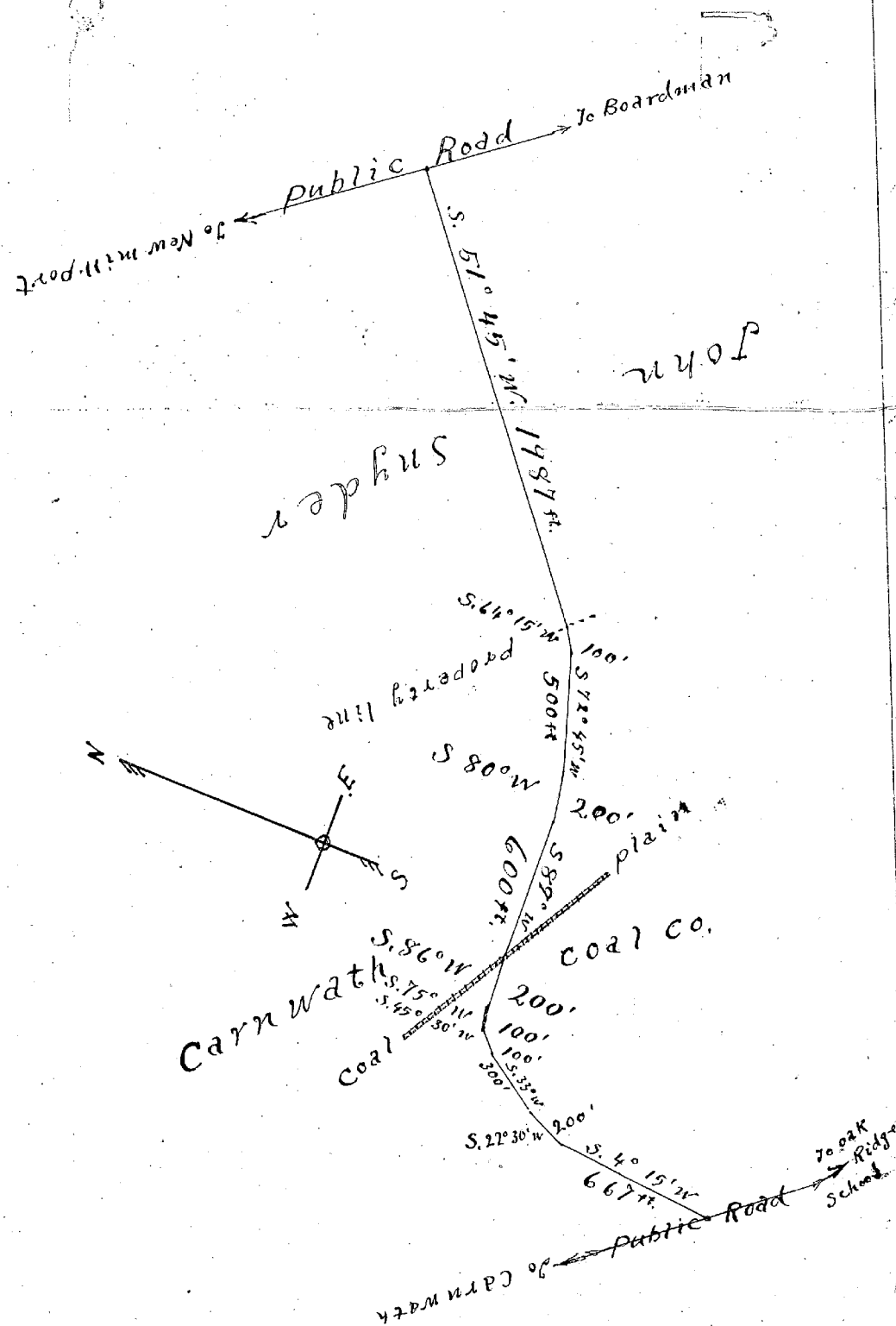
NOTE.—In case of a private road, the release must be executed in favor of the petitioner for said road.

Also, viewers will carefully note the number of days employed and set the amount-out at the foot of their return.

Reviewers cannot interfere with the damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the reviewers.

N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.
