M. for the appointment of viewers to view a proposed vacation of a public road in said township leading from at or near Sanborn Hall to a junction of said road with a road leading from Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale at the foot of what is known as Low Hill and to supply the same by a road leading from at or near Sanborn Hall through the properties of Boynton, David Rittner, Charles Boughman and John Yearger to connect with the public road leading from Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale at a point about three hundred yards north of the point at which the road at which it is proposed to vacate connects with the road leading from Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale.

P E T T I O N

The petition of the undersigned citizens, residents and tax  
payers of Woodward Township respectfully represents:-

That the road leading from at or near Sanborn Hall to a point  
at or near the foot of what is known as Low Hill where it connects  
with the road leading to Houtzdale, passes down a very steep hill  
and the grades upon said roads are so steep so as to be impracti-  
cable for hauling thereon at most seasons of the year. Said  
road can be vacated and supplied by a road which will be a better  
road and will be free from the steep grades that are on the said  
road as follows, to wit:- Commencing at or near Sanborn Hall;  
thence leading through the properties of Mrs. Ai. F. Boynton or  
Boynton and Dill and land of David Rittner, Charles Baughman and  
John Yearger, there to connect with what is known as the road  
leading from Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale at a point about three  
hundred yards from the foot of Low Hill and the point where the  
road as at present located leading with the Public Road from  
Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale.

Both said roads, to be vacated, and the road for which  
same is to be supplied are located in Woodward Township in said  
County.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully pray Your  
Honorable Court to appoint viewers to view the ground for the  
location of the road as at present existing and also the ground

over which the road to supply the existing road is to be located, and to vacate said existing road leading from the Sanborn Hall to a junction of said roads at the foot of Low Hill with a road leading from Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale and supply the same by a road leading from at or near Sanborn Hall through the properties hereinbefore mentioned to a point on the road leading from Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale about three hundred yards north of the point where the existing road so to be vacated joins said road leading from Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale.

NOW THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH that whereas the above named obligors or some of them together with other citizens and residents of Woodward Township in the County of Clearfield are herewith presenting their petition to the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pa., asking for the vacation of a certain piece of a public road located in said Township of Woodward extending from at or near Sanborn Hall in said township to the foot of what is known as Low Hill where it joins a Public road leading from Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale and supplying the same by a public road leading from at or near Sanborn Hall to connect with road leading from Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale at a point about three hundred yards north of the connection of said road to be vacated, with said road leading from Sanborn Bridge to Houtzdale.

Now if the above obligors shall pay any and all costs and expenses connected with the proceedings to vacate and supply the above stated road when legally required to pay the same as provided by law then this obligation to be void and of no effect, or otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
