PETITION FOR LAYING OUT OF PUBLIC ROAD

To the Honorable Singleton Bell,
President Judge of the said Court.

Sir:

The petition of the undersigned citizens of Pennsylvania and taxpayers and inhabitants of Girard Township, in said County, respectfully represent:

That your petitioners labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway in said Township which road shall begin at a point in Girard Township on the present road from Bald Hill Village to Bald Hill railroad station of the New York Central Railroad, the said point of beginning being located one hundred twenty-five feet northwardly on said present road from the present highway bridge over Bald Hill Run, which bridge is four hundred feet, on said present road, away from the end of said present road at said Bald Hill railroad station; the other terminal in Girard Township of this proposed road petitioned for shall be a point on the West Branch of the Susquehanna River. At this same time citizens and taxpayers and inhabitants of Bradford Township are petitioning your Honorable Court for a new public road to run to the said River on the Bradford Township side from a point in Bradford Township near the residence and barn of Guy Kline; which point is four hundred feet away from the said barn, that is southwest of the said barn, on the present highway that runs from the J.E. Livergood Estate residence to the village of Woodland; And the citizens, taxpayers and inhabitants of both said Townships and other Townships in said County are at this time also petitioning your Honorable Court for the location and construction of a bridge over said River from the terminal of said proposed road on the Bradford Township side of said River to the terminal of the said proposed road on the Girard Township side of the said River.

Your petitioners therefore pray your Honorable Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the said road according to law. And your petitioners will ever pray.



RETURN OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace for the County of Clearfield:

We, the undersigned viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, beg leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of view and of the hearing day was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County and the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Girard ----- and that three notices thereof were posted along the route of the proposed road, that the said view would be held on the 26th day of October -----, A. D 1921, and the hearing to be held in the Arbitration room, at the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the 28th day of October 1921, at 9, o'clock A. M. That the viewers appointed by the said order viewed the ground proposed for the above mentioned road, and that there were present at the view Dr. H. H. LEWIS one of the Supervisors of Girard Township ----- in favor of the road: -----

parties in interest. That the hearing was held in the Arbitration Room, in the Court House, at Clearfield, Pa., on the 28th day of October 1921, when the following appearances were noted: G. E. Smith one of the Supervisors of Girard Township E. R. Leiby, James O. Leonard Rebecca Smith, Rev Thomas F McGovern. Q. E. Beaunzenia, Frank Kolivosky, Mike Kolivosky, James Flood and others.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace, of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, Pa., in and for said County, on the 29th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred twenty-one.

Judge of the same Court. Upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the Township of Girard

in said County, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway in said Twp. which road shall begin at a point in Girard Twp. on the present road from Bald Hill Village to Bald Hill R.R. Station of the N.Y.C.R.R. the said point of beginning being located 125 feet northwardly on said present road, away from the end of said present road from the present highway bridge over Bald Hill Run, which bridge is 400 feet, on said presnrt road away from the end of said present road at said Bald Hill R.R. Station; the other terminal in Girard Twp. of this proposed road petitioned for shall be a point on the West Branch of the Susquehanna River. and therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the road between the points mentioned, whereupon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint from and among the County Board of Viewers A. G. Kramer, Esq., Harry Reese and E. D. Billotte.


who have been duly appointed by the Court and filed their oaths of office and are duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment, are to view the ground proposed for the said road, and if they view the same, and a majority of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioner, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, in such a manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances and references to the improvements through which the same may pass; (and wherever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said road at an elevation not exceeding five degrees, except at the crossing of ravines and streams, when by moderate filling and bridging the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit;) to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said County:

And if the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of locating a public road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road shall pass, releases from any damages that may arise to them on opening the same; but if the owner or owners of such land refuse to release their claim to damages, the said viewers shall assess the same, taking into view the advantages as well as disadvantages arising from said location, and make report of such assessments; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft or plot aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when, and place where, they should meet, to view and lay out said road, and the time and place of hearing.

ORDER

To view a road for public use in the township of Girard, Clearfield County, Penna.

Note.—In case of a private road, the release must be executed in favor of the petitioner for said road.

Also, viewers will carefully note the number of days employed and set the amount out at the foot of their return.

Reviewers cannot interfere with the damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the reviewers.

N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.


at and before the ensealing and delivery hereof, have remised, released and forever quit-claimed, and do hereby remise, release and forever quit-claim to, the said
