

RETURN OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGE OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF THE PEACE, IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD, PA.

We, the undersigned Viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, beg leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of the view and of the hearing day was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County, and the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Girard, _____, and that Three notices thereof were posted along the route of the said road to be vacated, that the said view would be held on the

25th day of August _____, A. D. 1921, and that the public hearing, as required by the Act of Assembly, and the Rules of Court, would be held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House, in Clearfield,

Pa., on the 26th day of August _____ A. D., 1921, at nine o'clock A. M., and that said Viewers, appointed by the said order, viewed the road desired to be vacated, and that there were present at the view no one but the viewers _____

parties interested, either in favor of or against vacating said road. And that the aforesaid hearing was held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the 26th day of August _____, A. D. 1921, when the parties interested in the said road were in attendance: _____

And that after the view and hearing above mentioned, the undersigned Viewers do agree that said road has has, become useless, inconvenient and burdensome to wit: Leading from a point in the public road leading from Frenchville to Bald Hills, three hundred and thirty (330) feet North west of the guide board near the Murray Graveyard where the road leading to Odessa connects with the road leading to Frenchville. Thence running over partly unimproved and partly improved land of Aaron Murray: North ten (10) degrees forty five (45) minutes: East, ten hundred and thirty seven (1037) feet to the intersection of the public road leading from the Frenchville road to Odessa at the end of the lane leading from said road to the residence of Aaron Murray in Girard Township County and State aforesaid: _____

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, Pa., held at Clearfield, Pa., in and for said County, on the - 5th day of July in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one

By the Honorable Singleton Bell, President Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the Township of Girard, in the County aforesaid setting forth that
~~a public road was laid out in said township in 1918 extending from a point on public road leading from Clearfield to Karthaus near the Murzay graveyard, to connect with a public road leading from Shawsville to the Knobs near the residence of F. S. Shope. That a portion of said road commencing at a point about three hundred feet west of the Murray Graveyard and extending to a point where the lane of Aaron Murray intersects said road has never been opened, that the same is useless and unnecessary and would be a useless burden on said Twp. to have to open the same.~~

and, therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate said road between the points mentioned, whereupon the said Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and ap-

point from and among the County Board of Viewers A. G. Kramer, Esq., Harry Reese and

J. S. Michaels who have been duly appointed by the said Court on the County Board of Viewers, and filed their oaths of office in the office of the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid, as required by law and are, therefore, duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment, with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment; are to view the said road, and after having viewed the same, if they, or a majority of them, do agree that there is no necessity for said road, they shall proceed to vacate the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, and make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in and for said County, stating particularly whether there is any necessity for said road, or whether the same should be vacated; and the reason why, together with a plot, or draft, thereof showing the courses and distances with reference to the improvements through which said road passes.

And in case the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating said road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road passes, or otherwise affected, or damaged, by the vacating of said road, releases from whatever damage they may sustain by the vacation of said road; and in case the owners of such lands, or persons affected, thereby refuse to release their claim to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the same, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages, arising from the vacation of said road; and make report of such assessment; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft, or plot, aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn, or affirmed, according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when and the place where they would meet, to view said road and the time and place of hearing.


