TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGE OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS

The petition of William F. Krach respectfully represents that he is the owner of a piece of land situate in the Township of Brady, County of Clearfield, State of Pennsylvania, just east of the village of New Salem, along what is known as route 59 on the state highway leading from DuBois to Clearfield. That during the Summer of 1920 and 1921 the said Highway Department improved said highway by building a concrete road.
