That in accordance with the
said order, the Commissioners went upon
the part of Bradford Township, proposed
for a new School District, and after
making a full examination of the
Township, believe that under the present
arrangements, a large number of fam-
ilies are destitute of school privileges
some of them being nearly four
miles distant from the nearest
School, and we recommend the Er-
ection of an independent School
District, to include all the land
enclosed in red lines, on the Draft
