IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CLEARFIELD COUNTY.

To the Honorable Judge of said Court:

The petition of the undersigned citizens of Bradford and Boggs Townships respectfully represents:

That at May Sessions 1918 their petition was presented to said Court asking for appointment of viewers to view, vacate and supply a portion of a road leading from lower Woodland to Litz's Bridge in Boggs Township, between the Chestnut Grove School House in Bradford and the intersection of Wilson road near the Jesse Wisor line in Boggs Township.

The said viewers made a report vacating and supplying the above mentioned portions of said road, which report was confirmed absolute at September Sessions 1919.

Your petitioners further represent that a portion of the above mentioned road has not yet been built and on account of the nature of the ground is expensive to build; that said line can be changed, shortened and much less expensive to make and keep up.

They therefore pray your Honorable Court to appoint viewers to view and vacate above mentioned road from a point where the Jacob Parks and Turner lands join to a point where the same intersects the Wilson road, and to supply the same with a road beginning where the Jacob Parks and Turner lands join to a point on the Wilson road near the Alfred Hull residence.

And they will ever pray, etc.





and therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the road between the points mentioned, whereupon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint from and among the County Board of Viewers A. L. Edwards, Esq. Harry Reese and J. W. Spangle

who have been duly appointed by the Court and filed their oaths of office and are duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and according to the best of their judgement, are to view the ground proposed for the said road, and if they view the same, and a majority of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioner as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, in such a manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances and references to the improvements through which the same may pass; (and wherever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said road at an elevation not exceeding five degrees, except at the crossing of ravines and streams, when by moderate filling and bridging the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit,) to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said County.

And if the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of locating a public road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road shall pass, releases from any damages that may arise to them on opening the same; but if the owner or owners of such land refuse to release their claim to damages, the said viewers shall assess the same, taking into view the advantages as well as disadvantages arising from said location, and make report of such assessments; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft or plot aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when, and place where, they should meet, to view and lay out said road, and the time and place of hearing
