at Febraur Sessions 1920 .-

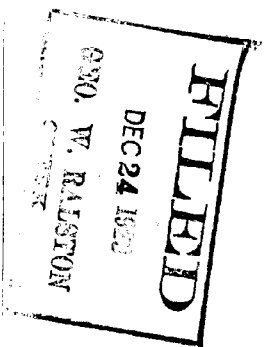
Your petitioners therefore pray your Honorable Court to

Sealed with our seals and dated the 15th day of December 1923

Whereas the said Russell B Neff and other citizens of Chest Township have petition the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County for the appointment of viewers to review a public road leading from the west end of the public Bridge across Chest Creek at five points and extending to the top of the Kitchen Hill at the division line between Chest and Burnside Townships

Now the condition of this obligation is such that if said viewers shall refuse to reinstate said road and the said Court shall direct that any portions of the cost incurred in said proceedings shall be paid by said Neff then when said cost are paid then this obligation to be void or else to be and remain in full force and virtue
