At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, Pa., held at Clearfield, Pa., in and for said County, on the 12th day of June in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and twenty four

By the Honorable ~~Singleton Ball~~ ^{A. R. CHASE}, President Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the Township of Beccaria, in the County aforesaid setting forth that
a public road in the said Twp of Beccaria, Beginning at a point near the residence of A. J. Fry on a public road leading from Utahville to Smoke Run and ending on a public road near #29 Shaft leading from Utahville to Smoke Run long since laid out has become useless, burdensome and hard and hard to keep and unnecessary

and, therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate said road between the points mentioned, whereupon the said Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and ap-

point from and among the County Board of Viewers A. L. Edwards, Esq., J. E. Fry
and J. W. Spangle who have been duly appointed by the said Court on the

County Board of Viewers, and filed their oaths of office in the office of the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid, as required by law and are, therefore, duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment, with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment; are to view the said road, and after having viewed the same, if they, or a majority of them, do agree that there is no necessity for said road, they shall proceed to vacate the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, and make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in and for said County, stating particularly whether there is any necessity for said road, or whether the same should be vacated; and the reason why, together with a plot, or draft, thereof showing the courses and distances with reference to the improvements through which said road passes.

And in case the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating said road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road passes, or otherwise affected, or damaged, by the vacating of said road, releases from whatever damage they may sustain by the vacation of said road; and in case the owners of such lands, or persons affected, thereby refuse to release their claim to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the same, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages, arising from the vacation of said road; and make report of such assessment; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft, or plot, aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn, or affirmed, according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when and the place where they would meet, to view said road and the time and place of hearing.



PETITION.

At a Court of Quater Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, at Clearfield Town, in and for said County, on the 9th day of September A.D. 1896, before the Judge of said Court, Asa Spencer, John Miller, and James Crago the persons appointed by an order of Quater Sessions, The petition of the undersigned represents:

That a Public Road has recently laid out in said Township of Beccaria beginning at a point in the Public road at or near the house of Jacob Mathews. That a portion of said road as viewed and laid out will be expensive to make and that the same as laid runs through a dwelling house recently built by George McKonish. That a new road to supply that portion of the aforesaid road running by the aforesaid house and lots can be cheaply constructed. Your Petitioners pray your Honorable Court to appoint viewers to review and lay out a road to supply that portion of the aforesaid road beginning at a post in the public road at the N.E. Corner of lot of George Alinsky, and ending at a point on public road 150 feet N. of the division line of Robison and Shoff

Do Report that in pursuance of the said Order, they have viewed and laid out, and do return for public use, the following road to wit: Beginning at a post in front of house of George Alinsky, thence N. 3 degrees 35 minutes West 305 feet to a post, thence N. 20½ degrees West 373 feet to a post, thence N. 14½ West 211.5 feet to post, thence N. 31½ degrees East 100 feet to post and place of beginning of Public Road.

That we the undersigned Petitioners are in favor of opening the road and we pray that the same shall be done as the opening Order has been lifted and presented to the Supervisors of Beccaria Township on the 11th day of April A.D. 1924, for the purpose of beginning work on said road. The Petitioners further believe that this road is a necessity, First: As it would be an outlet for Twelve (12) families living back where they have no outlet. SECOND: That this will make a straight line from Roots Corner to the Twenty Nine Road, which is considered the best location and an easy and cheap road to build.

THIRD: That the Taxpayers who live along this proposed road have no outlet or any public road leading to their properties and that they are entitled to a road as much as any one else.

FOURTH: That it will be an improvement to the Town of Beccaria, giving people an opportunity to build along said proposed Road, therefore opening up property that was heretofore closed to Public improvement, and we will ever pray.

Road in Beccaria Township) Exceptions to confirmation.

Exceptions are filed to the confirmation of the Report of the Viewers appointed in the View and Review of this road, alleging that the Viewers exceeded their authority in making recommendations as to vacation and supply of road not asked for in the petition and therefore the Report should not be confirmed.

The question of vacating raised by these proceedings has been vigorously contested. A View was held and then a Review was requested and had. The Viewers in both instances arrive at the same conclusions and made the same recommendations as to vacation of a certain portion of the road. It is true that the Board appointed to make the Review made certain recommendations as to changes that they thought should be made in the portion of the road not vacated, stating however that they had no authority to direct the change, in that the petition did not ask for a supply. Of course, any recommendations of the Viewers which was not asked for in the petition or its amendments can have no legal effect and can only be treated as surplusage, but the fact that something was recommended or suggested by the Viewers which was beyond their legal authority would not nullify their findings and recommendations as to the subject matter over which they had authority and jurisdiction.

Both the Viewers and Reviewers found from the evidence adduced before them that a certain portion of the road should be vacated as unnecessary and useless, while certain other portions were necessary for public travel. There is nothing to indicate that their conclusions were not correct or that there was any abuse of their authority. We are therefore compelled to dismiss

the exceptions and confirm the Report of the said Viewers.

Now, July 21st, 1925, exceptions dismissed at the costs of the Exceptants, bill sealed and exception noted.

It is further ordered and directed that the Report of the Viewers be presented at the proper time, as provided by the Rules of Court, for absolute confirmation.
