

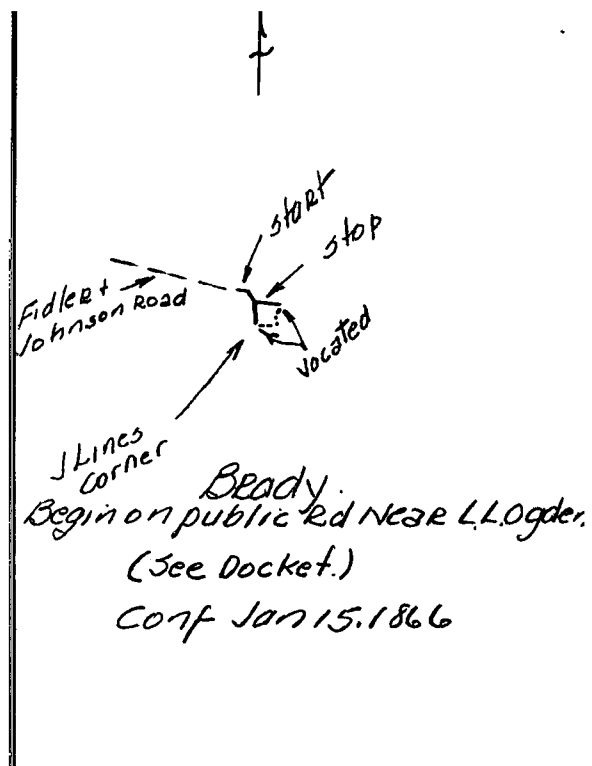

in and for said county
of the township of Brady and ss. of Clearfield. The petition
of divers Inhabitants, Respectfully shew-

cate and supply the same according

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the 22 day of June A. D. 1865 before the Judges of the said Court upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Brady in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway to lead from the Elmert road at or near S. S. Ogden's turn shop and to intersect a road leading from Stephen Hilders to James Johnsons at or near Ellen Bogals and thence to the Northwest corner of lands of Jesse Sims

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Roswell Smith Wm S Hamilton & James Mills

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

Said Court to view and lay out the road there in ment
ioned report that having first given public notice by
written advertisement at least ten day prior to said
view and also having been first all sworn & affirmed in
manner and form prescribed by the said order that
all of us Roswell Luther Wm J Hamilton & James
Miles having viewed the ground for the proposed
road did lay out and now return for the same for
a public road Beginning at a post on the Gettets road
near S. L. Ogden's road thence North Eighty one degrees
West thirty eight perches to the Stephen Peder &
Johnston road as altered by this order thence com
mencing at the corner of Ellenor Bogler's garden &
thence South Seventy Six degrees East eighteen
perches South fifty Seven degrees East ten perches
thence South forty one degrees East Seventeen
perches thence South forty eight perches to Jesse
Lines corner and so much of the ^{old} road as leads from
Said Bogler to Lines corner is by this alteration vacua
ted & thence from said Lines corner thence North eighty
degrees East thirty eight perches thence North twenty
two degrees West twenty two perches thence North
twenty two & a half degrees East twenty perches
to post on the Gettets road and place of Beginning
this last road beginning at Lines corner and ending
at the post on the Gettets road is hereby vacated &
and supplied by the first mentioned road in this
report a draft or plat of which is Roswell Luther
hereunto annexed as witness James Miles
and hands this 14th day of August 1865 Wm J Hamilton
