CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield,
held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the 22 day of
March A. D. 1863 before the Judges of the said Court upon
the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Knock*
in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience
for the want of a road or highway to lead from *Mount Hill*

church in Jordan Tp to James
La Crosse & Cummins in Knoc Tp.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

H. B. Wright, Joseph Patterson & David Wise,

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

We the viewers above named having first given
Ten days previous notice by six printed handbills
put up as required by law, of the time and place of meeting
and having also given notice to the owners of lands through
which said road is intended to pass, of the time of
the view, and having first been duly Affirmed, and
having all met on the 5th day of June A.D. 1865 and viewed
the ground for a road between the points mentioned
in the foregoing Order do report that in our opin-
ion such a road is necessary for the public
convenience, and that taking into consideration the
advantages of said road No damages accrue to any
of the owners of land through which said road
passes, and we do hereby report in favor of a road
between the points named; a draft of which is
hereto annexed, described as follows, Beginning at
Jacksons Sawmill South 79° West twenty three
perch, thence South 56° West sixty perch, thence South
 55° West twenty six perch, thence South 48° West forty
four perch, thence South 62° West nineteen perch, thence
South 82° West forty eight, thence West twenty five
perch, thence North 75° West ten perch, thence North 68°
West seventeen perch, thence North 62° West seventeen perch
thence North 43° West sixty three perch, thence North 89°
West twenty perch, thence North 43° West thirteen perch
thence North South 42° West sixteen perch, thence North
 33° West thirty three perch, thence North 80° West twenty
eight perch, thence North 43° West seventy four perch
thence 58° West thirty two perch to public road
