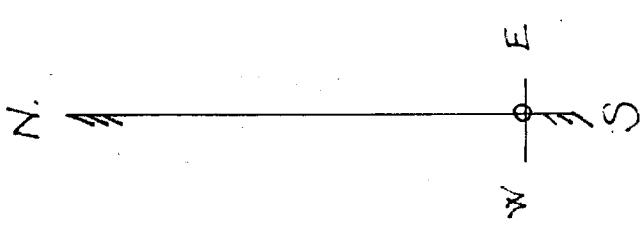

And the said viewers having due notices posted along the route of the said road to be vacated and notice served on County Commissioners of Clearfield County and the Supervisors of Goshen Township of the time set for the view, met at or near the Residence of Ed Taylor of the time set for the holding of said view met on Thursday October 24th

By the Honorable Judge A. R. Chase of the said Court: Upon the petition of said Supervisors of the Township of Goshen, in the County aforesaid setting forth that the.....

A Certain road in said Township of Goshen which has long since been laid out as township road but has through time become abandoned to the use of the general public and at present is used exclusively as a Private road or lane a more detailed description of same being a road beginning at or near the Residence of Taylor in northeasterly direction about one half mile in length to the intersection of the road leading from Thom Taylors to the Goshen Church about half mile in length to the Goshen Church in said Township. That to keep and maintain said road at the expense of Goshen Township has become useless inconvenient and burdensome to the taxpayers of the township. Therefore praying the said Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate said road between the points mentioned whereupon

and, therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate said road between the points mentioned, whereupon the said Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and ap-

point from and among the County Board of Viewers A. G. Kramer, Esq., E. D. Billot &

Jack Michaels who have been duly appointed by the said Court on the County Board of Viewers, and filed their oaths of office in the office of the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid, as required by law and are, therefore, duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment, with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment; are to view the said road, and after having viewed the same, if they, or a majority of them, do agree that there is no necessity for said road, they shall proceed to vacate the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, and make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in and for said County, stating particularly whether there is any necessity for said road, or whether the same should be vacated; and the reason why, together with a plot, or draft, thereof showing the courses and distances with reference to the improvements through which said road passes.

And in case the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating said road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road passes, or otherwise affected, or damaged, by the vacating of said road, releases from whatever damage they may sustain by the vacation of said road; and in case the owners of such lands, or persons affected, thereby refuse to release their claim to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the same, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages, arising from the vacation of said road; and make report of such assessment; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft, or plot, aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn, or affirmed, according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when and the place where they would meet, to view said road and the time and place of hearing.

of the Township of Goshen, and that due Legal notices thereof were posted along the route of the said road to be vacated, that the said view would be held on the

(24th) day of October, A. D. 19'29 and that the public hearing, as required by the Act of Assembly, and the Rules of Court, would be held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House, in Clearfield,

Pa., on the (25th) day of October A. D., 1929, at nine o'clock A.M., and that said Viewers, appointed by the said order, viewed the road desired to be vacated, and that there were present at the view besides the viewers the Supervisors of the Township to wit

Joseph Morris, Ira J. Kramer and Boyd H. Kyler in favor of the vacation of said road and Ed Taylor with other members of his family opposes to the vacation of said road the owner of the main part of the land over which said road passes. and thereby making the distance to the said Church and parties interested, either in favor of or against vacating said road. And that the aforesaid hearing was held

As the distance by the main road to the Goshen Church by the main road is but very little if any further which passes by the same and a better road a better road and that by the keeping up of the road by Ed Taylor Residence will be keeping up for the one family alone

The viewers therefore Recommend that the same be vacated.

Before said view was made due proper notice of the view to be made was regularly served on the County Commissioners and time set for the view and hearing posted along the route of the road to be vacated ten days before the day set for the view and hearing

and that a plan, or draft, of said road to be vacated showing the courses and distances, and over whose property the said road passes, is hereto attached and made a part hereof.

The undersigned Viewers further report that they endeavored to procure from all parties affected by the vacation of said road, a release in writing of all claims to damages that may arise from the vacation thereof, and that they procured such release from:

Reviewers cannot interfere with the damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the reviewers.

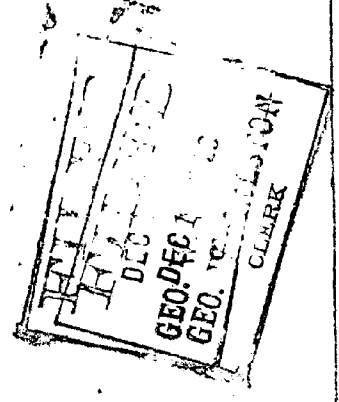
N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.
