Your undersigned, who are the Supervisors of said Sandy
Township, in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, would respectfully
represent;

That the pieces of public road in said Township, hereinafter
designated as the FIRST PIECE and the SECOND PIECE, respectively,
have become useless, inconvenient and burdensome to the said
township, because that both are in part layed out over low, swampy
ground and because of other and better roads in the vicinity, have
been practically abandoned for public travel, and ought in the
opinion of your petitioners, to be vacated.

FIRST PIECE; Beginning at the intersestion of another public
road, at the house of Duncan Allsbaugh, and extending Westerly
across the State Highway from Sabula to Penfield and ending at the
cement highway near the house of Nancy VanCise;

SECOND PIECE; Beginning at the A. R. VanTassell Farm barn
and extending westerly through the VanTassell Farm to the line
of the City of DuBois;

Your petitioners therefore respectfully pray that the Court
appoint Viewers to view the said sections of public road aforesaid
which many years ago were layed out and opened by virtue of an or-
der of this court, and to vacate the same. And they will ever pray.

Supervisors
of the Township of Sandy, in the County aforesaid setting forth that the....

the pieces of public road in said Township, hereinafter designated as the
first and second piece, have become useless, inconvenient and burdensome
to the said township, because that both are in part layed out over low,
swampy ground and because of other and better roads in the vicinity

First: Beginning at the intersection of another public road, at the house
of Duncan Allsbaugh, and extending Westerly across the State Highway from
Sabule to Penfield and ending at the cement highway near the house of
Nancy Vancise.

SECOND: Beginning at the A. R. Van Tassell farm barn and extending
westerly through the Van Tassell farm to the line of the City of Du Bois.

and, therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate said road between the
points mentioned, whereupon the said Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and ap-

point from and among the County Board of Viewers John Scollins, Esq., J. E. Frye

and Geo. K. Weber who have been duly appointed by the said Court on the
County Board of Viewers, and filed their oaths of office in the office of the Court of Common Pleas of the
County aforesaid, as required by law and are, therefore, duly qualified to perform the duties of their appoint-
ment, with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment; are to view the said road, and after
having viewed the same, if they, or a majority of them, do agree that there is no necessity for said road, they
shall proceed to vacate the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, and make report
thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in and for said County, stating particularly whether
there is any necessity for said road, or whether the same should be vacated; and the reason why, together
with a plot, or draft, thereof showing the courses and distances with reference to the improvements through
which said road passes.

And in case the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating said road, they shall obtain from
the persons through whose lands the said road passes, or otherwise affected, or damaged, by the vacating
of said road, releases from whatever damage they may sustain by the vacation of said road; and in case the
owners of such lands, or persons affected, thereby refuse to release their claim to damages, the said Viewers
shall assess the same, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages, arising from
the vacation of said road; and make report of such assessment; which report they shall in like manner trans-
mit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft, or plot, aforesaid. In which said reports they
shall state that they have been sworn, or affirmed, according to law, and that due and legal notice was given
of the time when and the place where they would meet, to view said road and the time and place of hearing.

RETURN OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGE OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF THE PEACE, IN AND FOR THE
COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD, PA.

We, the undersigned Viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, beg leave to report as follows: to No. 2, May Term, 1931

That notice of the time of the view and of the hearing day was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County, and the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Sandy, and that three notices thereof were posted along the route of the said road to be vacated, that the said view would be held on the

28th day of April, A. D. 19 31, and that the public hearing, as required by the Act of Assembly, and the Rules of Court, would be held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House, in Clearfield.

Pa., on the 30th day of April A. D., 19 31, at 10:00 o'clock A.M., and that said Viewers, appointed by the said order, viewed the road desired to be vacated, and that there were present at the view: First View, 10:30 A. M.: Duncan Allsbaugh; and Second View, 11:00 A. M.: J. F. Hoover, Supervisor of Sandy Township, and A. E. Little

parties interested, either in favor of or against vacating said road. And that the aforesaid hearing was held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the 30th day of April, A. D. 19 31, when the parties interested in the said road were in attendance: J. F. Hoover, Supervisor of Sandy Township, being duly sworn, examined and cross-examined by your Board.

And that after the view and hearing above mentioned, the undersigned Viewers do agree that said road ~~has~~ have, become useless, inconvenient and burdensome to wit:

FIRST: Beginning at the intersection of this Road with the Road leading to Home Camp and Hickory Kingdom opposite the residence of Duncan Allsbaugh; thence North 70 degrees 15' West along lands of Duncan Allsbaugh 295 feet; thence North 60 degrees 45' West thereby 393 feet to post on line of lands of John E. DuBois and DuBois Motor Cycle Club; thence thereby North 72 degrees 15' West 124 feet to a post; thence still thereby South 89 degrees 15' West 650 feet to a post; thence thereby North 82 degrees 50' West 100 feet to a post; thence thereby North 68 degrees 15' West 160 feet to a post; thence thereby and along lands of Mrs. Nancy Vancise North 57 degrees West across State Highway Route #555 and Sandy Lick Creek 457 feet and ending at the old Concrete Road leading from Sabula to Mountain Run.

We further find that the aforesaid Road burdensome of up-keep and there is little if any travel thereon; that with the exception of the Duncan Allsbaugh land, who has more convenient outlet, the abutting properties are unimproved, with other out-lets. The Road serves no public use, and is therefore recommended for vacation.

SECOND: Beginning at a post opposite the A. R. Van Tassel barn, on Road leading from Maple Avenue to Resinger's Mill, thence North 73 degrees 15' West along lands of A. R. Van Tassel Estate 1200 feet to the City Line of DuBois.

We further find that the aforesaid Road passes over low, swampy land and is burdensome of upkeep, inconvenient and useless for public travel, and therefore recommended for vacation.

and that a plan, or draft, of said road to be vacated showing the courses and distances, and over whose property the said road passes, is hereto attached and made a part hereof.

The undersigned Viewers further report that they endeavored to procure from all parties affected by the vacation of said road, or over whose properties said road passes, or in any way damaged by the vacating of said road, a release in writing of all claims to damages that may arise from the vacation thereof, and that they procured such release from:

And that the following persons having, in the opinion of the Viewers, been damaged by the vacation of said road, and having refused to release the damages to which they may be respectively entitled to by reason of the vacation, and closing up of the said road, we, the undersigned Viewers, after having considered the advantages to be derived to them, do assess them damages and make report thereof, as follows:

Reviewers cannot interfere with the damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the reviewers.

N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.

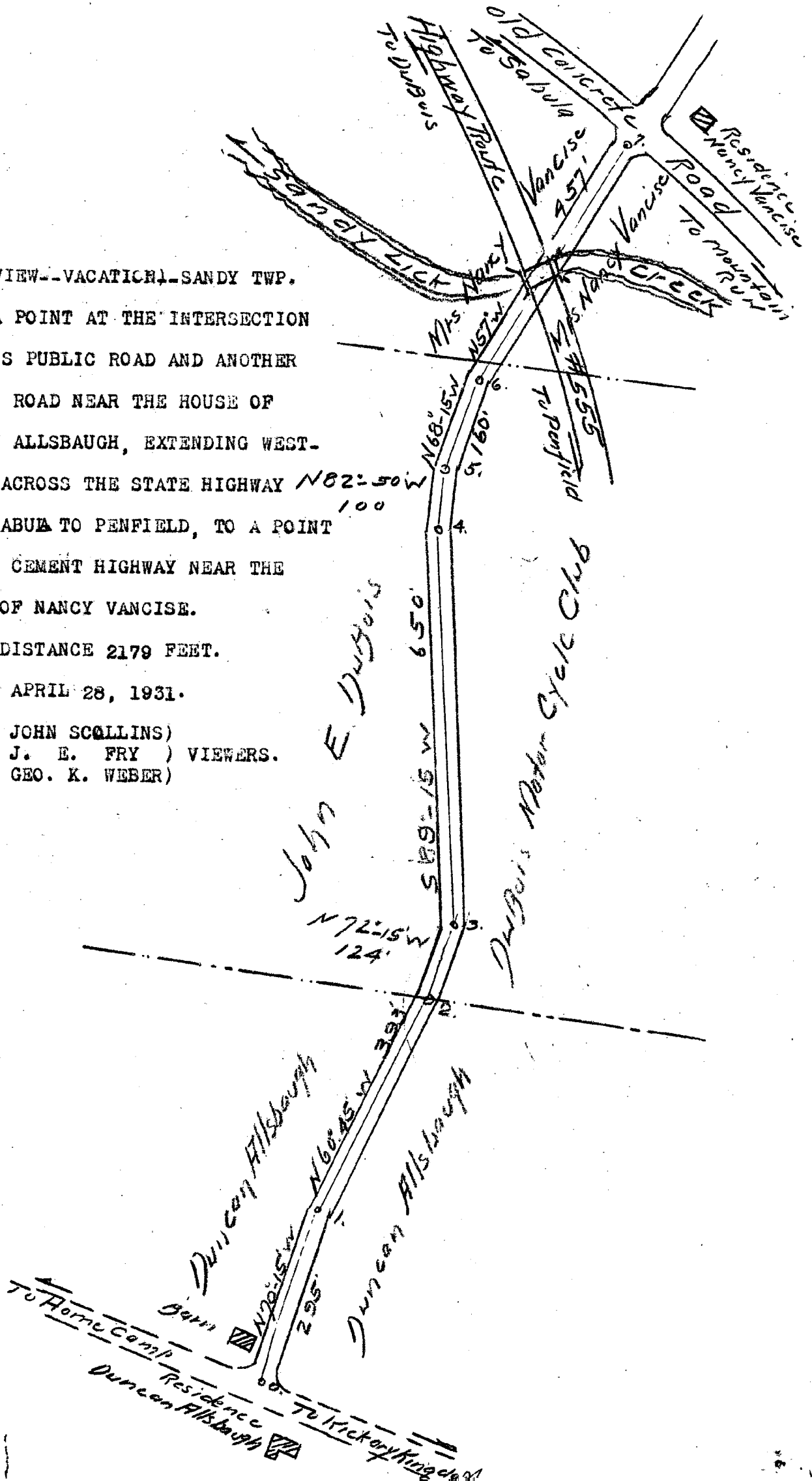
