

PETITION TO VACATE AND SUPPLY A ROAD IN BECCARIA TOWNSHIP.

To the HONORABLE A. R. CHASE, President Judge of said Court:

Your petitioners respectfully represent:

FIRST: That there has been long since laid out a public road in Beccaria Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, beginning at a point about thirty (30) rods East of the Fairview School House and two (2) miles South East of Irvona, and thence in a Northerly direction Three hundred and fifty eight (558) feet to a point of an intersection of a road and thence in the same direction Five Hundred and seventeen (517) feet to another intersection of public road.

SECOND: That there is a road that intersects the road mentioned in paragraph one (1), a distance of Three hundred and fifty eight (358) feet north of the beginning point and thence goes in a Southeasterly direction a distance of five hundred and twenty five (525) feet to a point on road leading from Irvona to Glen Hope, Pennsylvania.

THIRD: That an accurate description of the roads described in paragraph one (1) and two (2) was made by surveyor. A copy of which survey is attached to and made a part of this petition.

FOURTH: That the two above described roads

have become useless and burdensome and your petitioners pray the learned Court to appoint viewers according to the Act of Assembly, to vacate and abandon said road..

FIFTH: The petitioners propose a new road beginning at the point of Road No. 1, and thence in an Easterly direction a distance of two hundred and ninety four and five tenths (294.5) feet to a point where it intersects the road leading from Iriona to Glen Hope, Pennsylvania. This new road will take care of all the traffic of the public road to be abandoned.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners respectfully pray the Court to appoint viewers to vacate and abandon the roads described in paragraph one and two and supply said roads with new public road described in paragraph five (5).

1st these has been long since laid out a public road in Beccaria Twp, beginning at a point about 30 rods east of the Fairview School House and 2 miles east of Irvona, and thence in a northerly direction 358 feet to a point of an intersection of a road and thence in the same direction 517 feet to another intersection of public road.

2nd. That there is a road that intersects the road mentioned in paragraph 1, a distance of 358 feet north of the beginning point and thence goes in a south easterly direction a distance of 525 feet to a point on road leading from Irvona to Glen Hope, Pa. The above two described roads have become useless and pray that the same may be vacated and abandoned.

The petitioners propose a new road beginning at the point of Road No. 1, and thence in an easterly direction a distance of two hundred and ninety four and five tenths (294.5) feet to a point where it intersects the road leading from Irvona to Glen Hope, Penna. This new road will take care of all the traffic of the public road to be abandoned.

and, therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate said road between the points mentioned, whereupon the said Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and ap-

point from and among the County Board of Viewers John Scollins, Esq., Harry Reese

and Jack Michaels who have been duly appointed by the said Court on the

County Board of Viewers, and filed their oaths of office in the office of the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid, as required by law and are, therefore, duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment, with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment; are to view the said road, and after having viewed the same, if they, or a majority of them, do agree that there is no necessity for said road, they shall proceed to vacate the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, and make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in and for said County, stating particularly whether there is any necessity for said road, or whether the same should be vacated; and the reason why, together with a plot, or draft, thereof showing the courses and distances with reference to the improvements through which said road passes.

And in case the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating said road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road passes, or otherwise affected, or damaged, by the vacating of said road, releases from whatever damage they may sustain by the vacation of said road; and in case the owners of such lands, or persons affected, thereby refuse to release their claim to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the same, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages, arising from the vacation of said road; and make report of such assessment; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft, or plot, aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn, or affirmed, according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when and the place where they would meet, to view said road and the time and place of hearing.

We, the undersigned Viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, <sup>to No. 1, May Sessions, 1932</sup> beg leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of the view and of the hearing day was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County, and the Board of Supervisors

of the Township of **Beccaria**, and that **three** notices thereof were posted along the route of the said road to be vacated, that the said view would be held on the **and the adjourned view on the 5th day of April, 1932** **9th** day of **March**, A. D. 1932, and that the public hearing, as required by the Act of Assembly, and the Rules of Court, would be held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House, in Clearfield. **and the adjourned hearing on the 8th day of April, 1932** Pa., on the **11th** day of **March** A. D., 1932 at 10:00 o'clock A. M., and that said Viewers, appointed by the said order, viewed the road desired to be vacated, and that there were present at the view: **on March 9th, 1932: Harry Killian, Jos.
