versus Township,

To the Hon. the Judges of the Quarter
Sessions, Court of Leinister Co. Du
at Sept. 1. 1860.

The undersigned
citizens of Girard township, in said County,
respectfully present, That the public road
leading from the Susquehanna river at a point about
a mile below Bald Heill's Run to the Kanthaus
road near William Murray, — is in such a situation
as to be impracticable and useless as a public ^{road} and
has been so for about ten years past, and can
not be properly put in order on the same ^{ground} without
very great expense beyond what is reasonable, or
the township is able to bear, — and your petitioners
believe the road may be put on better ground
between the same points and where it can
be made with one tenth the expense, if
indeed any road is necessary, of which your
petitioners think there is some doubt.

Your petitioners therefore pray that the said
road be vacated, and if the viewers deem ~~the~~
public road necessary between the same points, then
to supply the same, and so that ^{may} that view,
may be appointed to view and report &c —
