

ORDER OF COURT.

NOW October 10, 1934, it appearing to the Court that this petition is for the vacation of a road just granted by View confirmed February 6, 1934, and only a part of which has been constructed, and that it is therefore in fact a petition for Re-view after the time when such Re-view is a matter of statutory right, a new view in accordance with the petition is awarded, upon condition, however, that within ninety days the petitioners shall file a bond for the payment of the costs of the proceeding in the sum of one hundred dollars; the rights of all parties, including parties interested in the question of damages, being preserved in statu quo during that period.

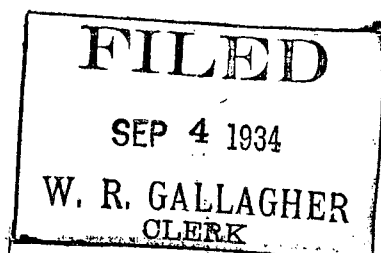
O R D E R.

PETITION TO VACATE

To the Honorable W. Wallace Smith, President Judge of said Court:

The petition of the undersigned citizens and residents of Union Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, being the majority of the citizens who petitioned the Court for the opening of the road hereinafter described, do hereby respectfully represent:

FIRST: That a petition praying for viewers to view and lay out a highway known as East and West Street in the Village of Rockton in Union Township, beginning at the East side of the Shellinbarger Road, commonly known as the DuBois Road, and continuing thereon fifteen hundred feet to the Rockton Public Cemetery located near the Mennonite Church, was filed to No. 9 May Sessions, 1933, and Viewers duly appointed by your honorable Court on May 1, 1933.

SECOND. That pursuant thereto proceedings were duly had and a report of the viewers filed May 20, 1933, recommending the opening of said street.

THIRD. That the said report was confirmed absolutely February 6, 1934.

1. FOURTH. That an order to open was served upon the supervisors of Union Township on or about the 2nd day of June, 1934.

FIFTH. That the Supervisors, after due investigation and careful study, find that that part of said street beginning at the east side of North Street, commonly known as the LaBorde Road and continuing thereon (along East and West Street) eleven hundred ninety (1190) feet to Rockton Public Cemetery, will be useless, inconvenient and burdensome to the Township and will serve no material public need; that it will be expensive to open, requiring an outlay of approximately \$ 1000.⁰⁰ which the Township, in its present financial condition, is not able or prepared to meet; that the interests of the public would best be served by the vacation of such part of East and West Street in the Village of Rockton.

SIXTH. Your petitioners further say that the said road has not been opened.

THEY THEREFORE PRAY the Court to vacate the same and to cause such proceedings to be taken to that end as are directed by the Act of Assembly in such case, made and provided.
