Petition for vacation of Public road
in Sandy Township

Versus

To Honorable W. Wallace Smith, the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County;

Your undersigned petitioners who are Supervisors of Sandy Township in said county would respectfully set out-

That among the public roads in said township is a road which begins at the intersection of Dixon Avenue and South Main street, at which point also is the dividing line between Sandy Township and the City of DuBois.

The said road runs thence westerly being in part known as South Main Street Extension, past the old Speers Mill and ends near "The Cabins", in said Township in State Highway Route No. 322.

This road has for some years been maintained by the Highway Department of Pennsylvania and on their records is known as Route No. 17015, and has recently been permanently improved with a macadam top.

When making the improvement, the Highway Department, straightened the road by building a part on a new location practically parallel with a part of the old road; the said part of the old road being thereby abandoned when the new road was opened to public travel about a year ago.

The part so abandoned is approximately 3160 feet in length, extending from a point at Station 5-45 to a point at Station 37-05, and is entirely in woodland, having along it no improvements of any kind and is no longer traveled by the public.

The said piece has thus become useless, burdensome and inconvenient and the Supervisors therefore petition the Court to appoint Viewers to view and vacate the said piece.
