The petition of W. L. Schoening, Levi Haymer, and
Blake Summers respectfully represents:

(1) That your petitioners are the duly elected
supervisors of the Township of Jordan, County of Clearfield,
State of Pennsylvania.

(2) That they are the legally constituted body for
the maintenance and construction of roads in the Township of
Jordan.

(3) That it is the desire of the supervisors to
vacate certain portions of Township road hereinafter described
so as to avoid dangerous curves and burdensome up-keep and
supply the proposed vacated portions as hereinafter setforth.

(4) Therefore your petitioners pray that the following
sections or portions of Township road be vacated and supplied
as follows:

(a) Beginning at the point of intersection of State
Highway Route No. 17021 and Township Road No. 436 at or near
Fruit Hill Schoolhouse; thence in a Northerly direction along
Township Road Route No. 436 a distance of approximately 150 feet.

The above portion of Township Road Route No. 436
to be vacated and abandoned and supplied by a new Road beginning
at a point where State Highway Route No. 17021 intersects Town-
ship Road Route No. 436 at or near Fruit Hill Schoolhouse; thence
in a Northerly direction a distance of approximately 100 feet to
a point where the newly proposed Road intersects Township Road
Route No. 436.

(b) Beginning at a point on Township Read Route No.
436 at or near Charley Lewis' property; thence in a Northerly
direction along Township Road Route No. 436 a distance of ap-
proximately 250 feet.

RETURN OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGE OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF THE PEACE, IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD, PA.

We, the undersigned Viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and had their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, beg leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of the view and of the hearing day was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County, and the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Jordan, and that three notices thereof were posted along the route of the said road to be vacated, that the said view would be held on the

22nd day of September, A. D. 1936, and that the public hearing, as required by the Act of Assembly, and the Rules of Court, would be held in the ~~Arbitration~~ Room in the Court House, in Clearfield,

Pa., on the 25th day of September A. D., 1936 at 10:00 o'clock A.M., and that said Viewers, appointed by the said order, viewed the road desired to be vacated, and that there were present at the view W.L. Schoning, Blake Sommers and Levi Hamer, Supervisors of the Township of Jordan.

And that the aforesaid hearing was held in the ~~Arbitration~~ Room in the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the 25th day of September, A. D. 1936, when the parties interested in the said road were in attendance: W.L. Schoning, Blake Sommers and Levi Hamer, Supervisors of Jordan Township.

And that after the view and hearing above mentioned, the undersigned Viewers do agree that said road has become useless, inconvenient and burdensome and that there is occasion for certain changes in Township Road Route #436 in the Township of Jordan and that such changes are believed necessary for the betterment and safety of public travel. And having had respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for such road and there being no damages claimed by the property owners as a result of the construction and relocation of said road, over whose property certain portions thereof will pass, we return for public use the following described road, the same to surplant the present Township Road Route #436, to wit:-

Beginning at a point, approximately 500 feet Northeast of the Fruit Hill School House, on State Highway Route #17021; thence North 6 degrees West, 375.5 feet to a point where the newly proposed road intersects Township Road Route #436; thence North 19 degrees West, 390 feet to a point where the newly proposed road intersects Township Road Route #436; thence along said Route 23 degrees West, 600 feet to a stake; thence North along said Route, 162 feet to a stake; thence North along said Route 37 degrees West, 470 feet to a stake; thence deviating from the old survey of Township Road Route 436, West 25 degrees 45' West, 700 feet to a point where the newly proposed route intersects Township Road Route #436; thence crossing said Route, North 25 degrees 47' West, 400 feet to a point where the newly proposed road again intersects Township Road Route #436 at or near McNeal Run.




