BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED - That the road supervisors of Woodward Township accept and adopt as Township Highway, the following described roads:- Beginning at a point on Route 17045 which is 0.16 miles southwest of intersection of Routes 17045 and 53; thence south 0.2 mi. crossing Beaver Run to intersect with Township Route 17645, said road to be 33 feet in width.

Said road to be maintained by the Road Supervisors of Woodward Township.

Passed and approved by the Board of Supervisors of Woodward Township at a special meeting on Sept-28 1936.

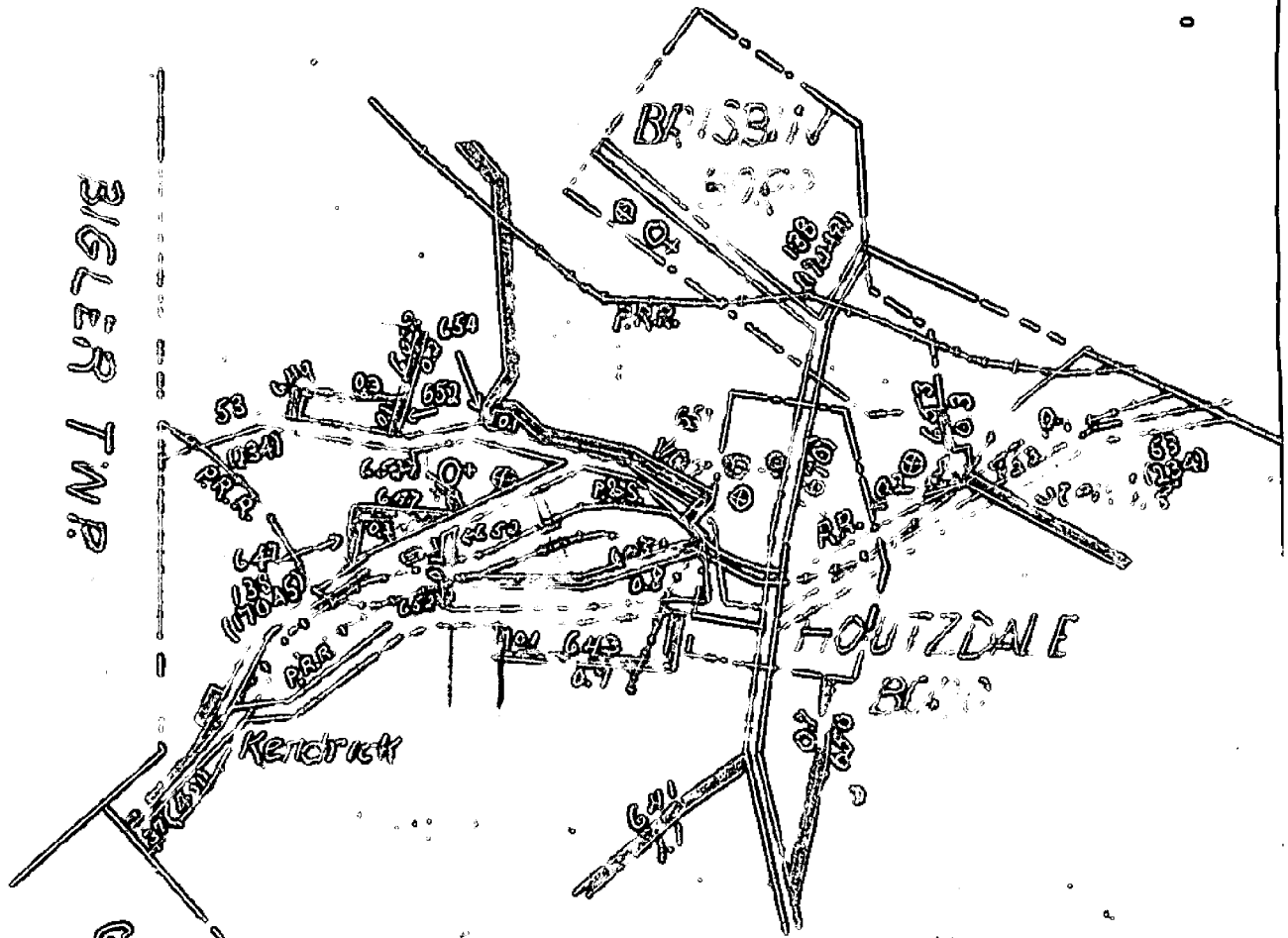
