TO THE Honorable Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County.

The petition of the subscribers, respectfully represents:

1. That the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Woodward, County of Clearfield and State of Pennsylvania, at a special meeting held at the regular meeting place in Woodward Township on the 28th day of September, 1936, passed a resolution duly accepting a certain dedicated road which is fully, adequately and completely described in said resolution.

2. That said road or alley-way has been used as a public road for upwards of forty (40) years.

3. That approximately one hundred (100) school children use this road to and from the public school in Woodward Township,

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray, that order may issue authorizing the Supervisors of the Township of Woodward, County of Clearfield and State of Pennsylvania, to accept said road or lane as a public highway,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED - That the road supervisors of Woodward Township accept and adopt as Township Highway, the following described road:- Beginning at a point on Route 17045 which is 0.16 miles southwest of intersection of Routes 17045 and 53; thence south 0.2 mi. crossing Beaver Run, to intersect with Township Route 17045, said road to be 53 feet in width.

Said road to be maintained by the Road Supervisors of Woodward Township.


Passed and approved by the Board of Supervisors of Woodward Township at a special meeting on Sept-28 1936.
