OF SAID COURT;

The petition of W. L. Schoening, Levi Haymer, and
Blake Summers respectfully represents:

(1) That your petitioners are the duly elected
supervisors of the Township of Jordan, County of Clearfield,
State of Pennsylvania.

(2) That they are the legally constituted body for
the maintenance and construction of roads in the Township of
Jordan.

(3) That it is the desire of the supervisors to
change Township Route 422 the same being subject to wash-outs
and heavy maintenance expenses by vacating that portion herein-
after designated and supplying in place and in stead.

(4) THEREFORE, your petitioners pray that that portion
of Township road Route 422 be vacated, commencing at a point
where the said Route 422 intersects and joins road known as
Township Route 431, being the western terminus of the proposed
vacated road, thence along said Route 422 in an easterly direction
on said Route, a distance of approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, and that there
be supplied for and place of the proposed vacated portion a road
beginning at a point being the eastern terminus of the proposed
vacated piece and running due west to Township road 431, as the
western terminus of the proposed supply road. The distance of
the proposed supply road being a little less than the proposed
vacated portion.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that the Honorable
Court appoint viewers to view and report on the proposed vacation
and supply as prayed for in the foregoing petition.

THAT THERE be supplied for and place of the proposed vacated portion a road beginning at a point being the eastern terminus of the proposed vacated piece and running due west to township road 431, as the western terminus of the proposed supply road. The distance of the proposed supply road being a little less than the proposed vacated portion.

and, therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate said road between the points mentioned, whereupon the said Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and ap-

point from and among the County Board of Viewers A. B. Shaw, Esq., E. D. Billotte

and T. C. McGarvey who have been duly appointed by the said Court on the County Board of Viewers, and filed their oaths of office in the office of the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid, as required by law and are, therefore, duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment, with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment; are to view the said road, and after having viewed the same, if they, or a majority of them, do agree that there is no necessity for said road, they shall proceed to vacate the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, and make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in and for said County, stating particularly whether there is any necessity for said road, or whether the same should be vacated; and the reason why, together with a plot, or draft, thereof showing the courses and distances with reference to the improvements through which said road passes.

And in case the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating said road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road passes, or otherwise affected, or damaged, by the vacating of said road, releases from whatever damage they may sustain by the vacation of said road; and in case the owners of such lands, or persons affected, thereby refuse to release their claim to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the same, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages, arising from the vacation of said road; and make report of such assessment; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft, or plot, aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn, or affirmed, according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when and the place where they would meet, to view said road and the time and place of hearing.

RETURN OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGE OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF THE PEACE, IN AND FOR THE
COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD, PA.

We, the undersigned Viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, beg leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of the view and of the hearing day was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County, and the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Jordan, and that three notices thereof were posted along the route of the said road to be vacated, that the said view would be held on the

13th day of August, A. D. 1936 and that the public hearing, as required by the Act of Assembly, and the Rules of Court, would be held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the 15th day of August, A. D. 1936, at 10:00 o'clock A. M., and that said Viewers, appointed by the said order, viewed the road desired to be vacated, and that there were present at the view W.L. Schoning, Blake Sommers, and Levi Hamer, Supervisors of the Township of Jordan also E.W. Strong, Secretary of the Jordan Township Road District.

parties interested, either in favor of or against vacating said road. And that the aforesaid hearing was held in the Arbitration Room in the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the 15th day of August, A. D. 1936, when the parties interested in the said road were in attendance: W.L. Schoning, Blake Sommers and Levi Hamer, Supervisors of the Township of Jordan.

And that after the view and hearing above mentioned, the undersigned Viewers do agree that said road has become useless, inconvenient and burdensome and that there is an occasion for a public road as desired by the petitioners and that the same is believed necessary for a public road. And having had respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for such road and there being no damage claimed by Blake Sommers over whose property the newly proposed road is to pass, we return for Public use the following described road, to wit:-

Beginning at a point on Township Road Route #422 in the Township of Jordan, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, approximately 1386 feet distant from the point where said Township Road Route #422 intersects Township Road Route #431 in said Township of Jordan; thence North 21 degrees forty-five minutes West 300 feet to a stake; thence North 31 degrees fifteen minutes West 300 feet to a stake; thence North 47 degrees thirty minutes West 400 feet to a stake; thence North 34 degrees West 368 feet to a point where the newly proposed road intersects Township Road Route #431.

That after the view and hearing aforementioned, the undersigned viewers do agree in accordance with the prayer of the petition to vacate the section of road hereinafter described as having become useless, inconvenient

and burdensome to wit:-

Begining at the intersection of Township Road Route #422 and Township Road Route #431 in the Township of Jordan; thence in a Southeasterly direction a distance of approximately 1386 feet along Township Road Route #422 to a point where the newly proposed road as hereinabove described has its begining.

That the section of road that is being vacated is situated in a ravine and because of its location and close proximity to a small stream, is subject to damage by high water and particularly during heavy rain storms which cause the road in its present location to be frequently washed and damaged. That the road in its present location is burdensome to the Township of Jordan and although the condition of this road could be greatly remedied by the struction of a large culvert to divert the surpluss water from off the highway, it is the opinion of your undersigned viewers that the construction of such a culvert would not be practical and that the Township would still be burdoned, especially with extremely high water and that the public interest would be more conveniently and economically served by the supplying of a public road as hereinbefore laid out and recommended.




and that a plan, or draft, of said road to be vacated showing the courses and distances, and over whose property the said road passes, is hereto attached and made a part hereof.

The undersigned Viewers further report that they endeavored to procure from all parties affected by the vacation of said road, or over whose properties said road passes, or in any way damaged by the vacating of said road, a release in writing of all claims to damages that may arise from the vacation of said road, that they procured such release from:

And that the following persons having, in the opinion of the Viewers, been damaged by the vacation of said road, and having refused to release the damages to which they may be respectively entitled to by reason of the vacation, and closing up of the said road, we, the undersigned Viewers, after having considered the advantages to be derived to them, do assess them damages and make report thereof, as follows:

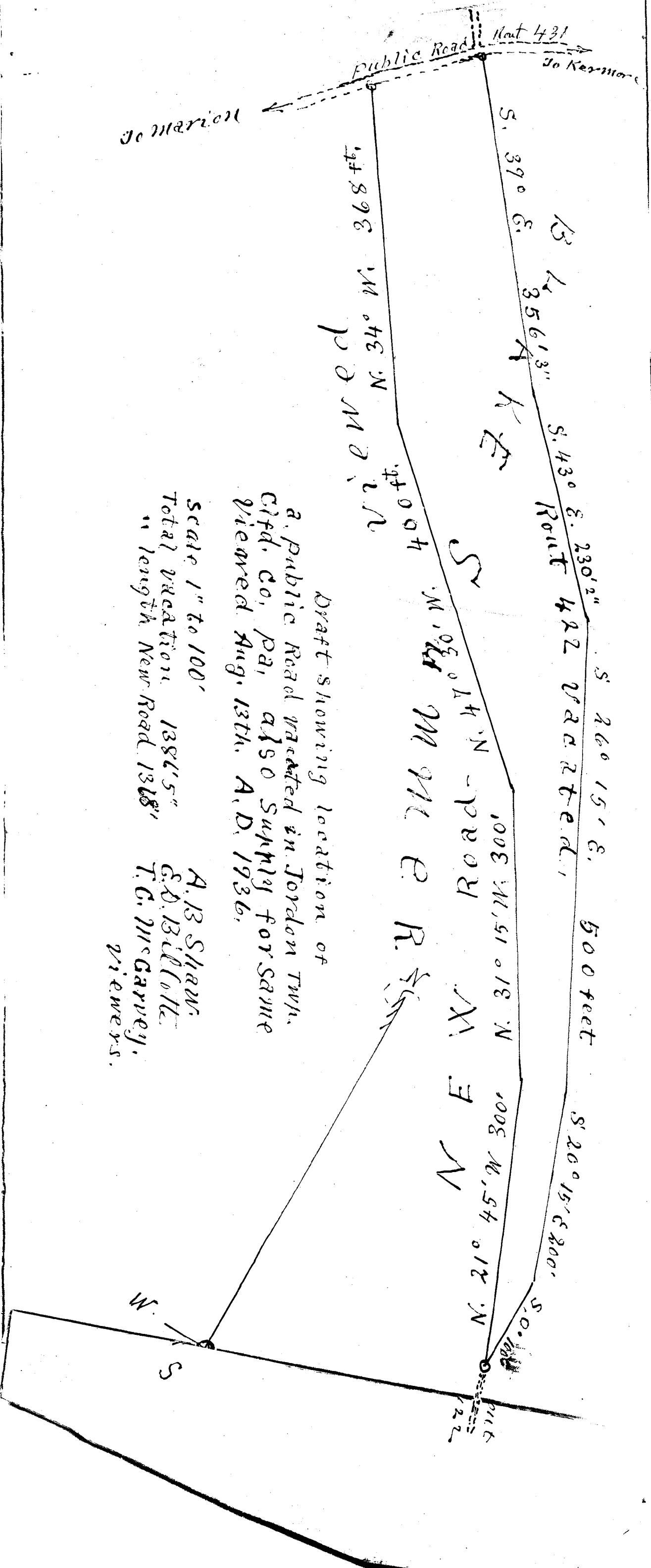
