County Bridge

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court
of Quarter Sessions of Cheasfield County.

The petitioners of the Commissioners of
Cheasfield County respectfully represent.

That after proceedings had in this Court
according to law, a bridge over Anderson
Creek at the place where a public highway
to Lumber City crosses, was intended of record
as a County Bridge, and the petitioners
Commissioners aforesaid, having procured an
estimate of the cost thereof which estimate
amounted to three thousand

dollars, entered into a contract with William
H. Miller for the erection of said bridge for the
sum of Two thousand eight hundred
dollars, and that said bridge is now comple-
ted. The petitioners therefore pray six feet perches
to erect said bridge & make report thereof to
the said Court.

We the Committee of
brewers appointed by the Court of
Common Pleas of Clarissa County
to inspect the new bridge recently
built across the mouth of Ander-
sons Creek near Cumwensville, do
Report that having met and
viewed the same according to ap-
pointment, we find the same
done in a neat, substantial, and
workman like manner; Having
met on the 10th inst, and viewed
the same, but owing to peculiar sit-
uation of the North east abutment we
find that the pier head spoken of in
the article of agreement would be no
protection to said abutment, we
therefore for the safety and protection
of said abutment, ~~we~~ agreed with
the said Wm. H. Miller and Sam-
uel Kierman to build a wharf of
sixty five feet in length by eight feet
in breadth, to ^{the height} of six feet, to be filled
with stone, The said Miller &
Kierman have built the same accor-
ding to our prescriptions, ~~and~~ for
which we recommend the ~~for~~ Commis-
sioners to pay the ^{said} Miller & Kierman
the sum of three hundred and sev-
enty ~~five~~ dollars. And we further
recommend that ~~that~~ the said Con-
tractor be paid an ~~additional~~ sum-

thing extra on the bridge contract
as we feel satisfied that said contractor
will loose ^{money} in the operation owing to
the extra price of lumber and boarding
in witness whereof we have here-
unto set our hands and seals.
