The Petition of the Road Supervisors of Boggs Township,
Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

(1). That your petitioners desire to accept and adopt,
as a public road to this Township Highway, a certain road
beginning at a point on the public road leading from Litz Bridge
to Clearfield, at the property of David A. Litz and ending at
the Stoneville Cemetery, for the purpose of furnishing access to
the said Cemetery and located in Boggs Township.

(2). That your petitioners at a regular meeting on the
3rd., day of August, A. D., 1937, adopted and approved a
resolution accepting the said road as described in paragraph

(1).

(3). That a copy of said resolution is attached hereto
and made a part of this petition.

(4). That said adoption and acceptance of said road is
in accordance with the Act of Assembly of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103
as amended by the Act of July 18, 1935, P. L. 1308.
