Clearfield County, ss:

At a court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield held at Clearfield, in and for the County aforesaid, on the 28th day of September A. D. 1866, before the Judges of the said Court upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the Townships of Lawrence, Boggs and Brown, in the said County, setting forth that they labour under great inconvenience for the want of a Bridge across the mouth of Little Clearfield Creek and the road leading from the Erie Turnpike to Glen Hope, and therefore praying the Court to appoint Commissioners to view and lay out a site for a Bridge according to law.

Whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint, James Mitchell, Charles Sloan & James Irwin, who, after being duly sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointments with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the place proposed for a site for said bridge, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for a bridge, shall make report thereof. (stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary, and whether any damages are claimed,) to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said County, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
