At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, Pa., held at Clearfield, Pa., in and for said County, on the 13th day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and thirty seven

By the Honorable ~~Supervisors and Citizens~~ ~~W. Wallace Smith~~, President Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of ~~Supervisors and Citizens~~ ~~W. Wallace Smith~~ of the Township of ~~Brady~~, in the County aforesaid setting forth that ..Within said township there in a public road beginning at State Highway No. 322, opposite the barn of P. W. Draucker, lately deceased, and extends first in a Southerly direction generally and then Westerly, ending in another public road at the Wingert School House;
That the first mentioned road is about to be permanently improved and that a part of said first mentioned road, beginning at a point of division between the lands of said Mrs. Herbert Pentz and Henry J. Wingert, crosses the said public road, and ending at a point in the said public road, almost opposite the farm house on said farm lands of Henry J. Wingert, has in said section, two sharp curves which in the opinion of your petitioners, ought to be eliminated when the said road is improved

and, therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate said road between the points mentioned, whereupon the said Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint from and among the County Board of Viewers A. B. Shaw, Esq., H. A. Giles

and E. D. Billotte who have been duly appointed by the said Court on the County Board of Viewers, and filed their oaths of office in the office of the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid, as required by law and are, therefore, duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment, with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment; are to view the said road, and after having viewed the same, if they, or a majority of them, do agree that there is no necessity for said road, they shall proceed to vacate the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, and make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in and for said County, stating particularly whether there is any necessity for said road, or whether the same should be vacated; and the reason why, together with a plot, or draft, thereof showing the courses and distances with reference to the improvements through which said road passes.

And in case the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating said road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road passes, or otherwise affected, or damaged, by the vacating of said road, releases from whatever damage they may sustain by the vacation of said road; and in case the owners of such lands, or persons affected, thereby refuse to release their claim to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the same, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages, arising from the vacation of said road; and make report of such assessment; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft, or plot, aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn, or affirmed, according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when and the place where they would meet, to view said road and the time and place of hearing.

RETURN OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGE OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF THE PEACE, IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD, PA.

We, the undersigned Viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, beg leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of the view and of the hearing day was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County, and the Board of Supervisors

of the Township of Brady , and that three notices thereof were posted along the route of the said road to be vacated, that the said view would be held on the

23th day of April , A. D. 1937, and that the public hearing, as required by the Act of Assembly, and the Rules of Court, would be held in the ~~Arbitration~~ Room in the Court House, in Clearfield.

Pa., on the 29th day of April A. D., 1937, at 10:00 o'clock A.M., and that said Viewers, appointed by the said order, viewed the road desired to be vacated, and that there were present at the view L. V. Duffy one of the Supervisors of the Township of Brady, Henry J. Winger and his wife and others.

parties interested, either in favor of or against vacating said road. And that the aforesaid hearing was held in the ~~Arbitration~~ Room in the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the 29th day of April ,

A. D. 1937 , when the parties interested in the said road were in attendance: There were no persons present at this hearing

And that after the view and hearing above mentioned, the undersigned Viewers do agree that said road has , become useless, inconvenient and burdensome and that there is occasion for a change in Township Road Route #17353 in the Township of Brady and that such change is believed necessary for the betterment and safety of the traveling public. And having had regard to the shortest distance and the best ground for such road and the least damage to the property owner whose land the same will pass, we return for public use the following described road, the same to supplant the present Township Road Route #17353 to wit:

Beginning at a point on the present Township Road Route #17353 on the Northern boundary line of the property of Henry J. Winger; thence South 6 degrees, 51 minutes East over land of Henry J. Winger, a distance of approximately 750 feet to a point on old Township Road Route #17353; thence South 20 degrees over land of Henry J. Winger a distance of approximately 144 feet where the newly proposed road intersects Township Road Route #17353.

The above mentioned road recommended by your undersigned Viewer's for construction will eliminate and supplant the present Township Road Route #17353, the same to be vacated and abandoned as follows:

Beginning at the point of construction of the new road on the Northern edge of the property of Henry J. Winger; thence South along Township Road Route #17353, approximately 590 feet to a stake; thence East along Township Road Route #17353 to a point where the present Township Road Route #17353 intersects the newly proposed road; thence South along Township Road Route #17353

a distance of approximately 134 feet to a point where the newly proposed road intersects Township Road Route #1735.

and that a plan, or draft, of said road to be vacated showing the courses and distances, and over whose property the said road passes, is hereto attached and made a part hereof.

The undersigned Viewers further report that they endeavored to procure from all parties affected by the vacation of said road, or over whose properties said road passes, or in any way damaged by the vacating of said road, a release in writing of all claims to damages that may arise from the vacation thereof, and that they procured such release from:

And that the following persons having, in the opinion of the Viewers, been damaged by the vacation of said road, and having refused to release the damages to which they may be respectively entitled to by reason of the vacation, and closing up of the said road, we, the undersigned Viewers, after having considered the advantages to be derived to them, do assess them damages and make report thereof, as follows: To Henry J. Winger 100.00, and in addition the Township of Brady will be required to cut down remove or burn, one large cherry tree and two small walnut trees near the barn adjacent to the road, also the sod or top soil removed in the construction of the new road is to be placed on the old Township Road to the West thereof, The Township of Brady is further required to place a closed sewer at the intersection of the new road and the old road, near barn and that said closed sewer be extended 20 feet below new Road to provide a crossing over said sewer into field adjacent to the barn.

N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.


