We, the Board of Township Supervisors of Bloom Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, hereby certify that the said Board convened at a special meeting on the 13th day of January, 1938, duly adopted a resolution which reads as follows:

"RESOLVED, that the Board of Township Supervisors of Bloom Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, hereby adopt as a township road all that certain county road described as follows:

"Beginning at a point on State Highway Route 59 about 1.4 miles north of the Penn-Bloom Township line; thence extending in a southeasterly and northwesterly direction by way of Goffe School to a point on State Highway Route 861 about 0.2 of a mile southeast of its intersection with State Highway Route 59."
