ORDER TO VIEW

At a court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace, begun on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of *July* A. D. 1938, and holden at Clearfield, in and for Clearfield County, before the Hon. W. Wallace Smith, President and Sole Judge, the following proceedings were had, to wit:

The petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Greenwood was presented, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road and bridge beginning at a point in Route No. 62 in the village of Curry Run near the J. R. Dickie Gasoline filling station and ending across the river at a point near the site of the New York Central Railroad station. Your petitioners therefore pray the court to appoint proper persons

to view and lay out the same. *The County Solicitor appears & gives notice of its intention to contest the proposed road.*  
Whereupon the court appointed as such viewers, *John Scott*  
*Esq., H. A. Reese and J. C. McCarney*

who, having ascertained that the requirements of the law respecting notices have been fulfilled, and having first been duly sworn or affirmed, are all to view the site and locality of the road proposed to be laid out, making a personal inspection of the ground between the points mentioned in the petition, and make report of their proceedings to the court at the next regular term, strictly observing the instructions which follow.
