The County of Clearfield by its County Commissioners, excepts to the viewers' report filed in the above entitled proceeding for the following reasons:


1. It appearing that the County Commissioners have at all times disapproved the purchase and reconditioning of the said bridge across the Susquehanna River as a County bridge and refused to accept said bridge as a County bridge, an essential portion of said highway cannot be laid out.
2. Without the said bridge the laying out of a road as recommended in the viewers' report would be a vain and useless thing.
3. Said proceedings are irregular in that the viewers' notice of view and hearing was silent as to the proceedings with reference to said bridge and the vacation of the old road.
4. Said proceedings are irregular and not in accordance with the provisions of the several Acts of Assembly in such cases made and provided.
