in Lawrence Township.

: No. 7 September Sessions, 1939

To the Honorable W. Wallace Smith, President Judge of said  
Court:

The petition of the Road Supervisors of Lawrence Township,  
Clearfield County, Pennsylvania respectfully represent.

1. That your petitioners desire to accept and adopt as  
township highways and streets, 18th Street from the intersection of  
said street with Route 53 of the Pennsylvania Department of Highways  
on Dorey Street to the point of intersection with Dorey Street; thence east/to the  
ash road leading from Route 53 in a southerly direction toward Krebs.  
Said streets were dedicated on the Weaverhurst addition to the  
Borough of Clearfield, which was dedicated as such on October 30,  
1910 and recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield  
County, Pennsylvania in Miscellaneous Book Volume 7, page 366.

2. That your petitioners at a special meeting on July 29,  
1939 adopted and approved a resolution accepting said 18th Street and  
Dorey Street, being 50 feet wide, on the plot of the Weaverhurst  
Addition to Clearfield Borough, as township highways and streets.

3. That a copy of said resolution is attached hereto and  
made a part of this petition.

4. That said adoption and acceptance of said street is in  
accordance with the Act of Assembly of May 1st, 1933, P. L. 103 as  
amended by the Act of July 18th, 1935, P. L. 1299.

Wherefore your petitioners respectfully pray that your  
Honorable Court will approve the adoption and acceptance of said

18th Street and Dorey Street, being 50 feet wide, on the plot of the Weaverhurst Addition to Clearfield Borough, as a Township highway and Streets.

RESOLUTION

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Road Supervisors of Lawrence Township accept and adopt as Township Highways and streets the following: 18th Street from the intersection of said street with Route 53 of the Pennsylvania Department of Highways to the point of intersection with Dorey Street; thence east<sup>on Dorey Street</sup> to the ash road leading from Route 53 in a southerly direction toward Krebs. Said streets were dedicated on the Weaverhurst addition to the Borough of Clearfield, being fifty feet wide.

Said street is to be maintained as a Township Highways by the Road Supervisors of Lawrence Township.

Passed and approved by the Board of Supervisors of Lawrence Township at a special meeting on July 29, 1939.
