The County Commissioners of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, entered into an agreement with Arven Williams and Lex Williams, as to the amount of damages to be paid on account of the taking of certain land for State Highway purposes, as the result of the change in width, lines and location of State Highway Route No. 57, Section 5, where said State Highway crosses the land owned by said individuals, in Bradford Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania. Said agreement was filed in the office of the Prothonotary of Clearfield County on the 2d day of September, 1939, and any taxpayer of Clearfield County may file exceptions to said agreement before the 18th day of September, 1939; if exceptions to said agreement are filed, the proceeding will be presented to the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, at ten o'clock A. M. on the 21st day of September, 1939, where any taxpayer may appear and be heard, together with his witnesses.
