To the Honorable, the President Judge of the said Court-

Your undersigned petitioners, the Supervisors of Sandy Township respectfully represent that the Work Projects Administration a Federal Agency, is engaged in improving one of the public roads in Sandy Township, leading from the Village of Clear Run toward Harvey's Run; the said road being known to the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as Route No. ~~27~~399;

That a section of this road between Station 0 - 0, and Station 5 + 0, of a distance of 500 feet, is in form of a right triangle, making a sharp curve in said road, and said agency have requested your petitioners to vacate the said road between said two stations and supply by moderately curved piece, which would be in form of a hypotenuse connecting the two legs of said right angle, and would be on better ground and of a length shorter than the present section of road.

That the only landowner affected by the change is the estate of John E. DuBois, Deceased, and his Executor has filed with your petitioners a release of damages, hereunto attached.

As the actual costs of constructing the said section will be borne by the Work Projects Administration, there will be no cost to said Sandy Township, in making the desired change, and as your petitioners believe, will, with approval of the Court, confer upon them the authority to vacate the existing section of road and supply it by adopting the new location shown on the map hereunto attached, as is provided in the Act of Assembly approved May 1st., 1933, P. L. 103, art. XI #1115, dispensing with formality of a view.

Wherefore your petitioners pray that the Court make an order approving such change, duly recited in the Minutes of the Board of Supervisors of Sandy Township. And they will ever pray.

O R D E R.


