DECATUR TOWNSHIP. Petition to
lay out a road for Public use

Versus

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, Pa., in and for said County, on the 27th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty one

Judge of the same Court: Upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the Township of Decatur in said County, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road in the said township, to begin at a point on Route 53 at the Midway, between Philipsburg and Osceola Mills, Penna., and extending in a northwesterly direction a distance of one-half mile where it intersects with Route 667.

That your petitioners, because of the lack of this road are isolated from the various highways and this effects at least seven residential properties.

and therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the road between the points mentioned, whereupon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint from and among the County Board of Viewers A. B. Shaw, Esq H. A. Reese, Esq., and T. C. McGarvey

who have been duly appointed by the Court and filed their oaths of office and are duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and according to the best of their judgement, are to view the ground proposed for the said road, and if they view the same, and a majority of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioner as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, in such a manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances and references to the improvements through which the same may pass; (and wherever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said road at an elevation not exceeding five degrees, except at the crossing of ravines and streams, when by moderate filling and bridging the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit,) to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said County.

And if the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of locating a public road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road shall pass, releases from any damages that may arise to them on opening the same; but if the owner or owners of such land refuse to release their claim to damages, the said viewers shall assess the same, taking into view the advantages as well as disadvantages arising from said location, and make report of such assessments; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft or plot aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when, and place where, they should meet, to view and lay out said road, and the time and place of hearing

RETURN OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace for the County of Clearfield:

We, the undersigned viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, be leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of view and of the hearing day was duly served according to law upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County and the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Decatur and that three notices thereof were posted along the route of the proposed road, that the said view would be held on the 13th day of November A. D. 1924 and the hearing to be held in the ^{Grand Jury} Arbitration Room, at the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the 15th day of November, 1924, at 10 o'clock A.M. That three viewers appointed by the said order viewed the ground proposed for the above mentioned road, and that there were present at the view Alex Davidson, George Myers, and Ben Hughes, one of the supervisors of the Township of Decatur.

After the view and hearing above mentioned, the undersigned, the majority of the said viewers, do agree that there is _____ occasion for a road as desired by the petitioner, and that the same is _____ necessary for a public road: And having had respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for such road we have laid out in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and as far as practicable agreeably to the desire of the petitioner, and do return for public use the following described road, to wit Beginning at the point of intersection of State Highway Route # 53 at the Midway between Philipsburg & Osceola Mills, Pennsylvania; thence South 77 degrees 45 minutes West over abandoned State Highway Route #53, 444 feet to point of intersection with dedicated street in the village of Gearheartville, Decatur Township, Clearfield County, known as Railroad Street; thence along said street South 88 degrees, 40 minutes West 800 feet along a stake; thence still along said Railroad St. South 85 degrees West 200 feet to a stake; thence still along said street North 79 degrees 45 minutes West 200 feet to a stake; thence still along said street North 68 degrees West 200 feet to a stake; thence still along said street North 46 degrees 15 minutes West 305 feet to a stake; thence still along said street North 41 degrees West 535 feet to point of intersection with State Highway Route #667 in the Township of Decatur, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania which leads from Osceola Mills to Philipsburg, Pennsylvania.

The proposed road hereinabove described, is laid out for the most part over a dedicated street, known as Railroad Street in the village of Gearheartville, Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, which said street forms the boundary in the deeds of conveyance by the original Grantors to the properties or lots which now abutt on said proposed road. For many years the individual property owners served by said street have kept the same in repair at their own costs and expense and in the opinion of your undersigned board, the newly proposed road over said street or route as laid out by the board is necessary for the

~~conveyance of the traveling public and should be kept up and maintained as a public road at public expense.~~

There are no objections to the proposed road, and according to the great number of petitioners requesting the same, its construction seems to be necessary for the accomodation of the traveling public, as well as for the convenience and accomodation of the great number of families living along said proposed road, so in view of these facts, your undersigned viewer's recommend the taking over and improvement of the aforementioned proposed road by the Decatur Township Road District for the use of the traveling public.





Also, viewers will carefully note the number of days employed and set the amount out at the foot of their return.

WHEREFORE your petitioners pray the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law.


