PETITION

To Honorable W. Wallace Smith, President Judge of said Court:-

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the Village of Grassflat, Cooper Township, in said County, respectfully represents:

That your petitioners labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway in the Village of Grassflat in said Township of Cooper, to begin at a point on legislative Route No. 17066 at the Kask property; thence in a Northerly direction a distance approximating One Thousand (1000) feet to the Grassflat Eighth Grade School House and passing in front of the Grassflat Grade School and to follow the course of a street or road now being traveled and used generally as a public road for upwards of twenty years but not a part of the township road system.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law.
