PETITION FOR REVIEW

TO THE HONORABLE W. WALLACE SMITH, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the Township of Sandy, County of Clearfield, Pennsylvania respectfully represents:

1. Upon the petition of sundry residents of Sandy Township, Clearfield County, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road in the Township of Sandy to begin at a point on the intersection of Hand Street and Northwood avenue, in the Wilson Terrace Addition of the said Township, and thence Westerly to Main Street Extension, at a point two hundred feet north of the residence of Pete Heberling, along said South Main Street Extension your honorable Court appointed Viewers to view the ground proposed for the said road and to make report of their findings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for Clearfield County.
2. That the viewers appointed by the said order viewed the ground proposed for the above mentioned road and after investigation and hearing made their report to the Court finding that the proposed road was not necessary to the convenience of the inhabitants of Sandy Township, Clearfield County.
3. The above mentioned report of the viewers against laying out the proposed road was filed November 23, 1942, and confirmed Ni. Si. at December Sessions, 1942.
4. That if the report of the viewers against the said road and the order confirming it Ni. Si. are confirmed absolutely your petitioners will be put to great inconvenience for the

want of a public road as prayed for in the aforementioned petition of the residents of Sandy Township.

Your petitioners therefore pray your honorable court to appoint proper persons to review the said road, and parts adjacent, and make report to the court, according to law; and they will ever pray.
