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Petition to Vacate certain portions
of a Public Road in Beccaria

Township Versus

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, Pa., held at Clearfield, Pa., in and for said County, on the 28th day of June in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.

By the Honorable ~~Singletary~~ ^{W. Wallace Smith}, President Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of ~~xxx~~ ^{xxx} Supervisors ~~inhabitants~~ of the Township of Beccaria, in the County aforesaid setting forth that a public road has long since been laid out in said township, Beginning at or near the Irvona Borough line, and extending Southerly to the Cambria County line, as shown by a plan thereof which is hereunto annexed, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, and is now known as Highway Route 170192.

That said public road has lately been improved from an earthen road to a natural stone base, macadam road.

That in the improvement of said road, portions of it as originally laid out and maintained has been relocated, as designated on the plan thereof hereto attached, and parts thereof have been abandoned and become unnecessary for public use and travel, and will be burdensome and dangerous to maintain.

and, therefore, praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate said road between the points mentioned; whereupon the said Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint from and among the County Board of Viewers A. B. Shaw, Esq., Thomas C. McGarvey

and E. D. Billotte who have been duly appointed by the said Court on the County Board of Viewers, and filed their oaths of office in the office of the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid, as required by law and are, therefore, duly qualified to perform the duties of their appointment, with impartiality and according to the best of their judgment; are to view the said road, and after having viewed the same, if they, or a majority of them, do agree that there is no necessity for said road, they shall proceed to vacate the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, and make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in and for said County, stating particularly whether there is any necessity for said road, or whether the same should be vacated; and the reason why, together with a plot, or draft, thereof showing the courses and distances with reference to the improvements through which said road passes.

And in case the viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of vacating said road, they shall obtain from the persons through whose lands the said road passes, or otherwise affected, or damaged, by the vacating of said road; releases from whatever damage they may sustain by the vacation of said road; and in case the owners of such lands, or persons affected, thereby refuse to release their claim to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the same, taking into consideration the advantages, as well as the disadvantages, arising from the vacation of said road; and make report of such assessment; which report they shall in like manner transmit to the next Court of Quarter Sessions, with the draft, or plot, aforesaid. In which said reports they shall state that they have been sworn, or affirmed, according to law, and that due and legal notice was given of the time when and the place where they would meet, to view said road and the time and place of hearing.

RETURN OF VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGE OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF THE PEACE, IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD, PA.

We, the undersigned Viewers, duly appointed by your Honorable Court by the foregoing order, from and among the County Board of Viewers who have been duly appointed by your Honorable Court and have filed their oaths of office in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, beg leave to report as follows:

That notice of the time of the view and of the hearing day, was duly served according to law, upon the Commissioners of Clearfield County, and the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Beccaria, and that three notices

thereof were posted along the route of the said road to be vacated, that the said view would be held on the

4th day of August, A. D. 1943, and that the public hearing, as required by the Act of Assembly, and the Rules of Court, would be held in the ~~Arbitration~~ Room in the Court House, in Clearfield,

Pa., on the 6th day of August A. D., 1943 at 10:30 o'clock A. M., and that said Viewers, appointed by the said order, viewed the road desired to be vacated, and that there were present at the view Ed Berger, Carl E. Weakland and Dale O'Donnell, Supervisors of the Township of Beccaria, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

parties interested, either in favor of or against vacating said road. And that the aforesaid hearing was held in the ~~Arbitration~~ Room in the Court House, in Clearfield, Pa., on the 6th day of August,

A. D. 1943, when the parties interested in the said road were in attendance: Ed Berger, Carl E. Weakland and Dale O'Donnell, Supervisors of the Township of Beccaria.

And that after the view and hearing above mentioned; the undersigned Viewers do agree that said road ~~has~~ become useless, inconvenient and burdensome or certain sections thereof which the State Highway of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, have abandoned by reason of the construction and relocation of State Highway Route #17019-2 in Gulich Township, have become useless, inconvenient and burdensome, and serve no usefull purpose whatsoever to the traveling public, and your undersigned viewers recommend that said ^{abandoned} portions of State Highway Route #17019-2 which under the law have reverted back to the Township of Beccaria, be vacated as a part of the Beccaria Township Public Road System.

The portions or sections of the old State Highway Route #17019-2 which have reverted back to the Township of Beccaria and which your undersigned Viewer's recommend be vacated as prayed for, are as follows:-

THE FIRST SECTION to be vacated has its beginning at Station #16 near the Cambria County line; thence over old State Highway Route #19019 in a northerly direction, a distance of about 525 feet to point at Station #21 on East side of new State Highway Route #17019-2, as relocated.

THE SECOND SECTION to be vacated has its beginning at Station #23, on the East side of the new State Highway Route #17019-2; thence over old

highway Route #17019 in a northeasterly direction, a distance of about 400 feet to a point at Station #30, on the East side of new State Highway Route 17019-2, as relocated.

THE THIRD SECTION to be vacated has its beginning at or near Station #35; thence in a northerly direction over old State Highway Route #17019, a distance of 300 feet to a point at Station #39, on the East side of new State Highway Route #17019-2, as relocated.

THE FOURTH SECTION to be vacated has its beginning at or near Station #42 on new State Highway Route #17019-2; thence in a northerly direction over old State Highway Route #17019, a distance of about 624 feet at a point at Station #48, on the West side of new State Highway Route #17019-2, as relocated.

THE FIFTH SECTION to be vacated has its beginning at or near Station #49 on new State Highway Route #17019-2; thence in a northerly direction over old State Highway Route #17019, a distance of about 600 feet to a point at Station #55, on the East side of new State Highway Route #17019-2, as relocated

and that a plan, or draft, of said road to be vacated showing the courses and distances, and over whose property the said road passes, is hereto attached and made a part hereof.






No damage resulted to the abutting property owners by reason of the vacation of the sections of old State Highway Route #17019 herein described.




