PETITION TO HAVE PUBLIC  
ROAD VACATED AS SUCH AND  
DECLARED A PRIVATE ROAD.

To the Honorable W. Wallace Smith, President Judge:

The Supervisors of Covington Township respectfully represent:

FIRST: That they are the Supervisors of the Township of Covington, County of Clearfield and State of Pennsylvania.

SECOND: That a Township Highway leads from State Highway Route No. 17052 at a point 17 $\frac{1}{4}$  feet west of Nestor Frelin's residence in the Township of Covington to the residence of Fred Picard a distance of 2,200 feet.

THIRD: That the said road leads through timber lands and is bounded by lands of Nestor Frelin, Hillary and Joseph Bergey and land of Henry Billotte.

FOURTH: That the only dwelling house directly affected thereby will be that of Fred Picard who has adequate highway facilities through other Township roads.

FIFTH: That all of the persons owning land abutting upon said road concur in the abandonment thereof and agree that the same may be left as a private road.

SIXTH: That the further maintenance of the Township Road above mentioned is burdensome to the Township and is not a convenience to the citizens thereof nor to the traveling public, their needs being adequately served by other highways.

SEVENTH: A blueprint of the above mentioned road is hereto attached, the portion to be vacated being shaded in red.

EIGHTH: That the abandonment of this Highway will not involve the Road District in any expense or in any claim or claims for damages by any of the abutting property owners.

Your petitioners therefore pray your Honorable Court that a decree may be entered permitting the abandonment of said Highway for public purposes, the same to be retained as a private highway for the use of the abutting property owners.


DECREE

NOW, January 27, 1943, the within petition having been presented and it appearing that the prayer thereof can be granted without inflicting damages upon abutting property owners and it further appearing that such property owners have consented to these proceedings,

IT IS ORDERED AND DECREED that that portion of the Township Highway in Covington Township, leading from the State Highway Route 17052, (beginning at a point 174 feet West of Nestor Frelin's residence) to the residence of Fred Picard, a distance of 2200 feet, be and the same is hereby vacated pursuant to the provisions of Section 1115 of the Second Class Township law of 1933, P.L. 103, the same being shown in red on the map hereto attached.
