Re: Road in Boggs & Decatur Twp.

Versus

RESOLUTIONS

On motion duly made and seconded, it was unanimously
RESOLVED, that pursuant to the Act of Assembly of May
28, 1943, P. L. 796, No. 333, the County Commissioners of
Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, do hereby consent to assumption of
responsibility by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department
of Highways, for construction, repair and maintenance of a
certain road located in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and
further consent to the establishment of the said road as a
state highway, said road being identified as follows:

"Beginning at a post at the intersection of Routes
17049 and 17049 Spur E in the village of Blue
Ball (West Decatur Postoffice) in Boggs Township,
Clearfield County, thence in a southeasterly direc-
tion through Boggs and Decatur Townships via
Jefferson School and Pleasant Hill to a point at
the intersection of Routes 17057 and 17057 Spur E,
in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, a distance
of approximately 2.73 miles." - Being the road shown
on the print hereto attached.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that certified copies hereof shall be


