To the Honorable F. Cortez Bell, President Judge of said Court:

The petition of the undersigned, Albert Graham,
acting for and in behalf of himself and others, respectfully
represents:

1. That your petitioner and others for whom he
is acting labor under great inconvenience for want of a public
road or highway beginning at the intersection of present sixteen
foot private road with the Egypt Road which runs from Pleasant
Valley Church to Susquehanna River, said sixteen foot private
road intersects aforesaid Egypt Road at Ferd Kephart property;
thence eastwardly one-half mile more or less over the course of
the present sixteen foot private road through Ferd Kephart land.

2. That along said proposed road resides Ferd
Kephart, Robert Graham, Walter Graham, Homer Graham, Ray Wisor, and
Albert ^{Graham} Wisor, all of whom join in this petition through Albert
Graham as their agent and representative.

3. That they have no proper and drivable access
to the aforesaid highway known as Egypt Road from their respective
places of residence.

and prays your Honorable Court to appoint a Board of Viewers to
view the premises and lay out a public road according to law.




DECREE

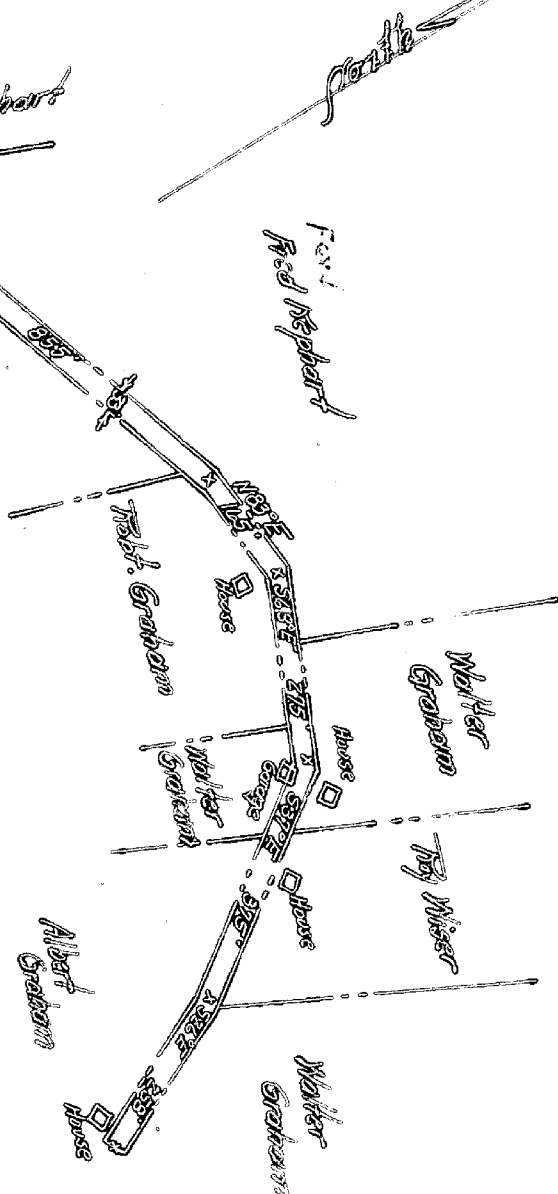
