ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION TO VACATE TOWNSHIP : :
ROAD NO. 420 for a distance of 0.8 miles and ROAD : RESOLUTION
NO. 438 FOR a distance of 1.5 miles IN FERGUSON :
TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA : :

WHEREAS, Township Road No. 420, which extends from State Road No. 17025 to Township Road No. 430, for a distance of 0.8 miles is no longer of practical use to the Township or the abutting property owners and should be abandoned as being unnecessary for the public convenience, and;

WHEREAS, Township Road No. 438, extending from State Road No. 857 to Township Road No. 444 and crossing said Township Road No. 444 and extending to Township Road No. 324, for a distance of 1.5 miles is no longer needed by the Township nor the abutting property owners and it is unnecessary to the public convenience, and;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid roads do not serve any useful purposes and that there are no abutting property owners in need of said roads, and:

WHEREAS, said roads should be abandoned as not being necessary for the public convenience.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ferguson, County of Clearfield and State of Pennsylvania, that the aforesaid Township Roads, to wit, No. 420 for a distance of 0.8 miles is no longer necessary for the public convenience and township road No. 438 for a distance of 1.5 miles is no longer necessary for the public convenience.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the aforesaid Township Roads be vacated and cease to be a part of the Township Road system.



MINUTES, MARCH 17, 1952

Special meeting called by Supervisors where all interested parties with properties abutting roads proposed to be vacated, could be present and opinions or oppositions heard. The roads in question being route 420 for a distance of 0.8 miles and Route 438 for a distance of 1.5 miles.

The Secretary to the Supervisors received one (1) respond to route 438 from Mr. Anthony Hile of Curwensville, by phone Mr. Hile agree that route 438 should be vacated no one of the other property owners appeared or contact the Board.

Mrs. Alta Ferguson and Mr. James W. Kearns of Clearfield appeared on behalf of Mrs. Hattie Williams in regards to Route 420. They expressed a desire to have this road remain open.

Mr. Merrell Condon and Mr. Anderson Shaffer being the only Supervisors present Mr. Condon made a motion that Route 420 remain open but to proceed to vacate route 438. The motion was seconed by Mr. Shaffer and carried.

The Supervisors advised the secretary to write Mr. Swoope and be advised how to proceed farther in the matter.
