

REPORT AND DRAFTS OR SURVEYS

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Gulich, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, files this Report and Drafts or Surveys in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the Act of Assembly of July 10, 1947, P.L. 1481 Sections 15 and 16.

1. That on the 18th day of June, 1949, notice was given of intention on the part of the Board of Supervisors of Gulich Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, to vacate or abandon certain sections of Township road by Ordinances.
2. That attached hereto is a copy of notices served on the property owners affected by the said abandonment.
3. That the property owners affected by said abandonment are: Robert Williams, Ramey, Pennsylvania, and Viola M. Rickenbaugh, Janesville, Pennsylvania.
4. That attached hereto are duly certified copies of two Ordinances enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Gulich Township at a meeting held June 30, 1949 pursuant to the notices given to the said property owners.
5. That attached hereto is a Draft or Survey of the proposed abandonments.
6. That attached hereto is a copy of the handbills posted on the abandoned roads.

Dear Sir or Madam:

Pursuant to Sections 15 and 16 of the Act of July 10, 1947 P.L. 1481 it is the intention of the supervisors of Gulich Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania to consider the abandonment of portions of a highway which had formerly been part of the State highway system and which under date of September 1, 1945 have been abandoned by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to Gulich Township. The said sections of road being a part of the former Department of Highways Route 859 and being formerly known as sections of Tuckahoe and Mt. Pleasant plank road more particularly described as follows:

THE FIRST THEREOF: Beginning at station 191+07; thence along its several courses and distances in a generally south-eastern direction to the Cambria County line at station 173+10.

THE SECOND THEREOF: Beginning at the Cambria County line at station 90+89; thence along its several courses and distances in a generally eastern direction to station 34+39 at the Cambria County line.

A meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Gulich Township will be held at 6:30 o'clock P.M., D.S.T., 5:30 o'clock P.M., E.S.T. on Thursday, the 30th day of June, 1949 at the Janesville School Building, Gulich Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania when and where you may attend and be heard concerning the proposed abandonment of the aforesaid parcels of road if you so desire.

ORDINANCE NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A ROAD OR SECTION OF ROAD WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF GULICH, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Supervisors of Gulich Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, it is in the interest of public convenience and economy to vacate, by Ordinance, a section of road herein described, now therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Gulich Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

Section 1. That in the judgment of the Supervisors, the following described road be and the same is hereby vacated:

All that certain section of road beginning at a point 1,500 feet East of the intersection of the said road with legislative Route 276 said point being at the present terminus of State Highway Route 859 at station 191+07; thence in a South Eastern direction along its various courses and distances 1,797 feet to the Cambria County line and station 173+10.

Section 2. That the Township Solicitor is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the office of the Court of Quarter Sessions together with the names of the owner or owners of property effected by the vacation of said road and a draft and survey of the road.

Section 3. That the Township Secretary shall within ten days from the date of this Ordinance give notice by handbills, posted in conspicuous places along the line of the proposed vacation; such notice shall state the fact of the passage of this Ordinance and the date of the passage.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Sections 15 and 16 of the Act of July 10, 1947, P.L. 1481 the Supervisors of Gulich Township hereby give notice that under the following Ordinances, sections of this road herein-after described have been vacated by the Board of Supervisors of Gulich Township.

By Ordinance No. 2, enacted June 30, 1949, and recorded in Ordinance Book No. 1, page 2, the following described road is vacated:


All that certain section of road beginning at a point 1,500 feet East of the intersection of the said road with legislative Route 276 said point being at the present terminus of State Highway Route 859 at station 191\*07; thence in a South Eastern direction along its various courses and distances 1,797 feet to the Cambria County line and station 173\*10.

By Ordinance No. 3, enacted June 30, 1949, and recorded in Ordinance Book No. 1, page 3, the following described road is vacated:

All that certain section of road beginning at a point 1,782 feet West of the intersection of Township Route 863 and legislative Route 859 spue E said intersection being in Cambria County and said point being at station 34\*39; thence in a Western direction along its various courses and distances 5,650 feet to a point on Cambria County line at station 90\*89.

A report and draft concerning the above Ordinances has been filed in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions on the      day of July, 1949, in pursuance of the above mentioned Act of Assembly.



ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A ROAD OR SECTION OF ROAD WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF GULICH, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Supervisors of Gulich Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, it is in the interest of public convenience and economy to vacate, by Ordinance, a section of road herein described, now therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Gulich Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

Section 1. That in the judgment of the Supervisors, the following described road be and the same is hereby vacated:

All that certain section of road beginning at a point 1,782 feet West of the intersection of Township Route 863 and legislative Route 859 spur E said intersection being in Cambria County and said point being at station 34\*39; thence in a Western direction along its various courses and distances 5,650 feet to a point on Cambria County line at station 90\*89.

Section 2. That the Township Solicitor is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the office of the Court of Quarter Sessions together with the names of the owner or owners of property effected by the vacation of said road and a draft and survey of the road.

Section 3. That the Township Secretary shall within ten days from the date of this Ordinance give notice by handbills, posted in conspicuous places along the line of the proposed vacation; such notice shall state the fact of the passage of this Ordinance and the date of the passage.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
