REPORT AND RESOLUTION

NOW, We, Joseph Young, Wallace Owens and Joseph Thompson,
Supervisors of Lawrence Township, do make report and resolve in favor
of the adoption and opening of the driveway as prayed for in the petition
as follows:

The original petition was dated April 17, 1948 and upon the filing
of the same the said petition not being complete by having release of all
claims for damages and a draft of said road petitioned was tabled in order
to permit petitioners to submit: release of damages and draft.

That said release and draft were submitted at the regular meeting
held August 6, 1949 and upon the filing of same the Supervisors caused notice
to be given and held a meeting for hearing on September 3, 1949.

That at said hearing no objections were made.

That the proposed driveway is an old road and has been in use for 21
years and more.

That said road on driveway as established is 16 feet in width (8) feet
measured at right angles on either side of the center line of the present
traveled driveway or alley, being, 1500 feet in length.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisors of Lawrence Township
hereby approve the prayer of the petition and hereby ordain and adopt and
lay out as a public alley of the Township the road described in the petition
and shown by draft.

TO THE HONORABLE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
LAWRENCE; CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA:

We, the undersigned residents and tax payers of
the Township of Lawrence and abutting owners or tenants to the
road commonly known as the Upper Mill Road, respectfully represent:

1. That said road begins at a point, the south-
west corner of the W. A. Collins property on Legislative Route
No. 17041, and continues thence in a southwesterly direction
approximately 1500 feet to the southwest corner of the property
of Mrs. L. A. Gearhart.

2. That during the past number of years your
petitioners, at their own expense and on their own time, attempted
to maintain this road in a traversable condition.

3. That due to a recent outbreak of water from
an abandoned mine this road has been damaged to an extent that
the petitioners are themselves unable to repair it.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that under the
proceedings set forth in the Act of Assembly of 1947, known as
the Township Code, your Honorable Board will take over and main-
tain the above described road as part of the Township Road System
of the Township of Lawrence.


