REPORT AND RESOLUTION

NOW, We, Joseph Young, Wallace Owens, Joseph Thompson, Supervisors of Lawrence Township, do make report and resolve in favor of the adoption and opening of the alley as prayed for in the petition as follows:

The original petition was dated August 7, 1948, and upon the filing of the same the said petition was tabled in order to permit petitioners to submit a draft of said proposed road.

That a draft of said road was submitted at the regular meeting held October 1, 1949, and upon the filing of same the Supervisors caused notice to be given and held a meeting for hearing on October 15, 1949.

That at said hearing held October 15, 1949 no objections were made or filed, the Supervisors decided to adopt said road as prayed for in the petition but adjourned the hearing to permit petitioners to have draft made to meet requirements and to submit the same for action.

That at a regular meeting on November 5, 1949 a draft was filed and is attached hereto along with the petition.

That the proposed road is an old road and has been in use for 21 years or more.

That said road or alley as established is 16 feet in width (8) feet measured at right angles on either side of the center line of the present traveled road or alley, being, 1935 feet in length.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisors of Lawrence Township hereby approve the prayer of the petition and hereby ordain and adopt and lay out as a public alley of the Township the road described in the petition and shown by draft.

PETITION REQUESTING THE  
SUPERVISORS TO DECLARE  
EXISTING ROAD A PUBLIC  
HIGHWAY AND RELEASE BY  
PETITIONERS OF DAMAGES.

WHEREAS, there is an existing sixteen (16) foot alley  
or highway leading from the Penfield Turnpike at the R. H. Thomp-  
son homestead property near the Paradise Schools to the J.F. Fink-  
beiner farm in Lawrence Township, and

WHEREAS there is no public record of the taking over of  
such highway notwithstanding the previous maintenance thereof by  
the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the undersigned freeholders, whose  
lands abut upon the said road which is not yet of record leading  
as aforesaid from the Penfield Turnpike at the R. H. Thompson  
homestead lands near the Paradise Schools in Lawrence Township, to  
the J. F. Finkbeiner farm, which road has been used for public  
travel and maintained by Township funds for a period of twenty-one  
years and upwards, do hereby respectfully petition the Board of  
Supervisors of Lawrence Township to enact a resolution accepting  
said road as a public alley (16 feet in width) pursuant to  
Section 1105 of the Township Act of 1933 P.L.103;

AND WE DO HEREBY SEVERALLY RELEASE, exonerate, quit-claim  
and forever discharge the said Township of Lawrence and the Road  
District thereof from any and all claim or claims for damages by

reason of the declaring of said road a public <sup>alley</sup> highway, as well as  
by reason of the improving, repairing and maintaining the same.
