RICHMOND and ALBERT WOOD respectfully petition your Honorable Court under the Act of July 10, 1947 P. L. 1481 sec. 15; as amended by the Act of May 2, 1949, P. L. 819 No. 216 sec. 1; Act of May 24, 1951 P. L. 370 sec. 13; as follows:

1. Your petitioners are electors and tax payers of Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

2. This petition is presented to require the Township Supervisors of Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Penna. to take over, keep and maintain as a township road the following described road located in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pa.:

BEGINNING and intersecting with Route 53 at the Ernest Dunlap Service Station; thence in a Northern direction to the intersecting corner at the residence of William Smiley; thence in a Westerly direction to the intersection of township road leading from Route 53 to Gearhartville.

3. A petition signed by 82 electors and tax payers of Decatur Township requesting the township supervisors of Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Penna. to take over, keep and maintain the aforesaid road as a township road, was presented to the township supervisors of Decatur Township at a regular meeting of the said township supervisors on or about April 7, 1952.

4. The property owners along such proposed township road have all signed a grant and release of a 33 foot right of way for such road to Decatur Township Road Board and a release of damage which might incur in the completion of the aforesaid road, said petition and grant are attached and made a part hereof.

5. There are 13 property owners along such proposed road.

6. The township supervisors of Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Penna. have retained in their possession copy of the aforesaid petition and

release and refuse to act thereon from April 7, 1952, to the present time, a period in excess of 60 days.

7. Attached hereto is a road map of Decatur Township, Clearfield County, on which the proposed township road is marked in red, showing it to be a strip of approximately 3000 feet.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray your Honorable Court that viewers be appointed and proceedings now be had on this petition under the general roading law as authorized by Act of July 10, 1947 P. L. 1481 sec. 15; as amended by the Act of May 2, 1949, P. L. 819 No. 216 sec. 1; Act of May 24, 1951 P. L. 370 sec. 13.



Reviewers cannot interfere with the damages assessed by the original viewers, except so far as the location may be changed by the reviewers.

N. B.—If the viewers believe the parties are not entitled to damages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.



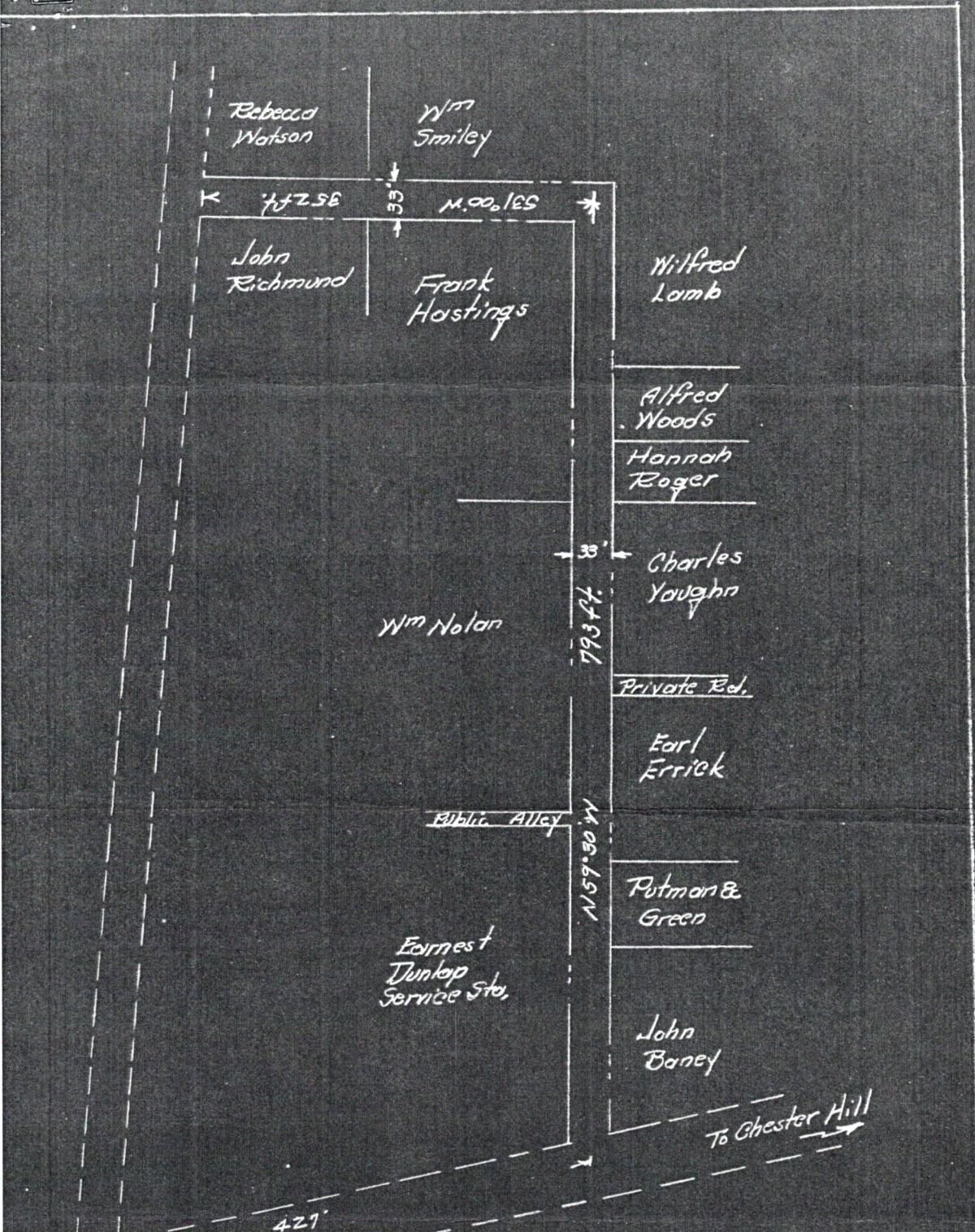

✓ After the view and hearing above mentioned, the undersigned, the majority of the said viewers, do agree that there is an occasion for a road as desired by the petitioner, and that the same is necessary for a public road: And having had respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for such road we have laid out in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and as far as practicable agreeably to the desire of the petitioner, and do return for public use the following described road, to wit Beginning at the point of intersection of state highway route 53 and dedicated street in the Village of Hudson at or near the Ernest Dunlap Service Station in the Township of Decatur, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania; thence extending over said street in a northwesterly direction 793 feet to the premises of William Smiley; thence extending in a southwesterly direction over dedicated alley and lands of William Smiley, Frank Hastings, Rebecca Watson and John Richmund a distance of 352 feet where said proposed road intersects the Township road, Route 671 in said Township of Decatur, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

The proposed road is laid out over a dedicated street, having a width of approximately 40 feet, and a dedicated alley, having a width of approximately 20 feet as aforesaid, long since in existence and used by the petitioners and residents of this alley. That for the past 25 years or more the individual property owners served by said dedicated street and alley, which leads from their residences to the main traveled highway, have maintained and kept the same in repair at their individual expense for themselves, as well as, for the traveling public, to the best of their ability.

That the 10 families specially served by said proposed road have fifteen children of school age who must use said proposed road going to and from school or to the school bus waiting station at the intersection of said proposed road with Township road, Route 671 as aforesaid, and because of its bad state of repair it is impassable
