PETITION.

To the Honorable John J. Pentz, president Judge of said Court:

The petition of Carl Weakland, J. J. Kachelries and
Merle L. Myers respectfully represents:

1. That they are the duly elected Supervisors of
Beccaria Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, a township
of the second class.

2. That plans of Cameron Street and Fifth Street in
the village of Windcrist (22),-hereto attached and made a part
hereof,- which said streets have been dedicated to public use
by the D. K. Ramey Estate and Berwind-White Coal Mining Company,
by declaration and descriptions in deeds of record in the
Recorder's Office of Clearfield County, having been duly adopted
and approved by your petitioners.

3. That the proposed roads as laid out over dedicated
but unrecorded streets in said village, each having a width of
50 feet, have for many years been maintained and kept up and in
repair by the individual property owners abutting thereon, for
their own families, as well as the public in general.

4. That the abutting property owners are unable to
adequately maintain said streets with no facilities for
properly grading and drainage required; and as said streets
are necessary for the convenience of the traveling public, and
in the opinion of petitioners should be taken over as part of

the public road system of Beccaria Township; that the proposed roads are within the confines of dedicated streets, and the advantages to the abutting properties exceed any disadvantages.

5. That said roads are located wholly within the village of Windcrist (22) in Beccaria Township, and are further described as follows:

(i.) CAMERON ROAD: beginning at a stake at the centre of the intersection of Cameron Street with Township Route 550 leading to Hagerty's "X" Roads: thence running North $38^{\circ} 48'$ East, 964 feet and ending at the McGlynn Farm, formerly known as the Cerwenial Place.

(ii.) FIFTH STREET ROAD: Beginning at a stake at the centre of the intersection of Fifth Street with Township Route 550 leading to Hagerty's "X" Roads: thence running North $74^{\circ} 42'$ East, 707 feet and ending at a Street leading at right angles to W. J. Twigg's Store.

6. Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a certified copy of a resolution duly passed by the Board of Supervisors of Beccaria Township, accepting said streets as part of the public road system of Beccaria Township.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner requests that your Honorable Court consent to the acceptance of portions of Cameron Street and Fifth Street in Windcrist (22) as contained within the lines of said streets, 33 feet in width, by endorsing your consent thereto, as provided by the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. 19093-1147).

BE IT RESOLVED: That the roads hereinafter designated, each thirty-three feet in width and each constructed to the requirements of this Board, be and the same are accepted as Township Roads subject to the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, to be endorsed hereon:

1. CAMERON ROAD: Beginning at a stake at the centre of the intersection of Cameron Street with Township Route 550 leading to Hagerty's "X" Roads: thence running North 38° 48' East, 964 feet and ending at the McGlynn Farm, formerly known as the Cerweniak Place.

2. FIFTH STREET ROAD: Beginning at a stake at the centre of the intersection of Fifth Street with Township Route 550 leading to Hagerty's "X" Roads: thence running North 74° 42' East, 707 feet and ending at a Street leading at right angles to W. J. Twigg's Store.



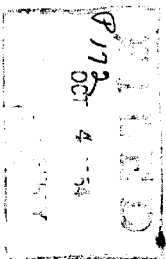
