PETITION.

To the Honorable John J. Pentz, President Judge of said Court:

The petition of Carl Weakland, J. J. Kachelries and
Merle L. Myers respectfully represents:

1. That they are the duly elected Supervisors of
Beccaria Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, a Township
of the second class.

2. That plans of Jackson, Washington, Jefferson and
Market Streets of the village of Rosebud, as laid out by
James Spangle, and recorded in the Recorder's Office of
Clearfield County, in Misc. Book 30, page 513, having been
dedicated to public use.

3. That portions of said Streets by proceedings had
to No. 2, September Sessions, 1947, under the general road
law, have been laid out and to be opened as public roads by
order and decree of the Court of Quarter Sessions, and filed
in the office of the Clerk of said Court.

4. That all of said roads are located wholly within
Beccaria Township, are 40 feet in width and are further
described as follows:

JACKSON STREET ROAD: Beginning at the intersection
of Jackson Street with Jefferson Street, and thence
running North 7° East, 370 feet and ending at the
northern intersecting line of Fulton Street.

WASHINGTON STREET ROAD: Beginning at the intersection
of Washington Street with Jefferson Street, and thence
running North 7° East 340 feet and ending at the south-
ern intersecting line of Fulton Street.

JEFFERSON STREET ROAD: Beginning at the intersection of Jefferson Street with Jackson Street, and thence running North 90° East, 720 feet and ending at Union Street, the Macadamized State Route 17112.

MARKET STREET ROAD: Beginning at the intersection of Market Street with Union Street, and thence running South 83° East, 320 feet and ending at Main Street, Township Route 879.

5. The acceptance of said roads would be of benefit to Beccaria Township and necessary for the accomodation of the traveling public; that the proposed roads are within the confines of the dedicated streets, have long since been opened for public use; and that the benefits accruing to the abutting property owners exceed any disadvantages to the users thereof.

6. Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a certified copy of a resolution duly adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Beccaria Township, accepting said streets as part of the public road system of Beccaria Township:

WHEREFORE, your petitioner request that your Honorable Court consent to the acceptance of the portions of Jackson, Washington, Jefferson and Market Streets as contained within the lines of said streets, 33 feet in width, colored in blue, by endorsing your consent thereto, as provided by the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. Sec.1147).

I hereby certify that the following is a true and correct copy of a resolution duly adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Beccaria Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, at a regular meeting of said Board held September 24 1954:

BE IT RESOLVED: That the roads hereinafter designated, each thirty-three feet in width and each constructed to the requirements of this Board, be and the same are accepted as Township Roads subject to the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, to be endorsed hereon:

1. JACKSON STREET ROAD: Beginning at the intersection of Jackson Street with Jefferson Street, and thence running North 7° East, 370 feet and ending at the northern intersecting line of Fulton Street.
2. WASHINGTON STREET ROAD: Beginning at the intersection of Washington Street with Jefferson Street, and thence running North 7° East 340 feet and ending at the southern intersecting line of Fulton Street.
3. JEFFERSON STREET ROAD: Beginning at the intersection of Jefferson Street with Jackson Street, and thence running North 90° East, 720 feet and ending at Union Street, the macadamized State Route 17112.
4. MARKET STREET ROAD: Beginning at the intersection of Market Street with Union Street, and thence running South 83° East, 320 feet and ending at Main Street, Township Route 879.


