Public Road in Penn Township

versus

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Part Twp. Rd. 17335

To the Honorable Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the County of Cleaveland

We the Viewers appointed by the foregoing Court of Court to review Vacate & Supply the road therein described. We Report that in pursuance of said appointment after having given ten days notice by printed & written advertisements put up according to law of the time and place of said review and no damages being claimed by any one we after being duly affirmed have reviewed laid out and return for public use the following road. Beginning at a post on Public road near Abraham Myrtle Barn thence South eight and a half degrees west fifty perches to line of Abram Myrtle and Martin Flynn thence by said line North Eighty Six degrees west Eighty three perches to a Post thence South three and a half degrees west Forty Eight perches to a Post thence South thirty three degrees west fifty two perches to Public road on top of Curryrun Hill near Jas Clearys road - a Plot or draft which we hereto annex.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the 21st day of *June* A. D. 1865 before the Judges of the said Court upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Perry* in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway to lead from *the farm of*

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to ^{re}view and lay ^{& supply} out the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Thomas A. Moore. Thomas Houser & Richard Sumner.

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
