Passed June 7th 1955

An Ordinance to lay out and open one road and to vacate portions of two other roads, entirely within the township of Brady, Clearfield County, Penna.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Supervisors of the township of Brady, Clearfield, Co. Penna., and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1: The following described road is laid out and opened as a Township Road of Brady, Clearfield Co. Penna.

Beginning at a spike on L. Rt 17016 said spike being at the intersection of said proposed road in a northerly direction 980' to a point of Curtis Carns and Walter Baker

Section 2: The following roads portions described is hereby vacated

- (1) Rt. 862 and Rt 366 in a Northerly direction a distance of 0.4 mile. Vacating Rt 366 in its entirety.
- (2) Penn Twp. and Rt. 334 in its entirety a distance of 0.17 mile in a Southwesterly direction.

Section 3: Any land owner who develops a plot of ground into building sites must provide 33 foot right of way and construct a road approved by the supervisors of Brady Township.

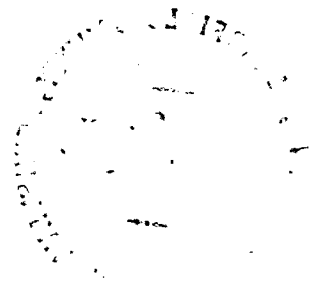
Section 4: This Ordinance shall become and hereby is in effect upon the date hereof: 1st of August, 1955

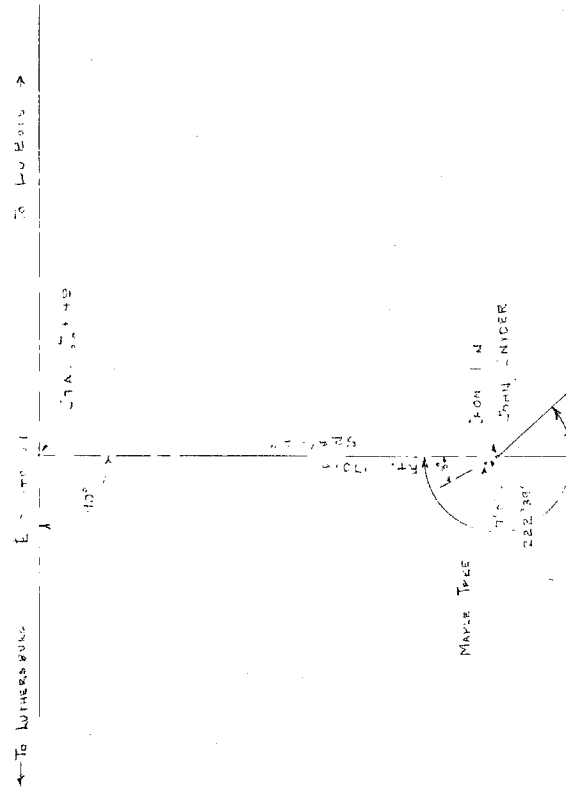

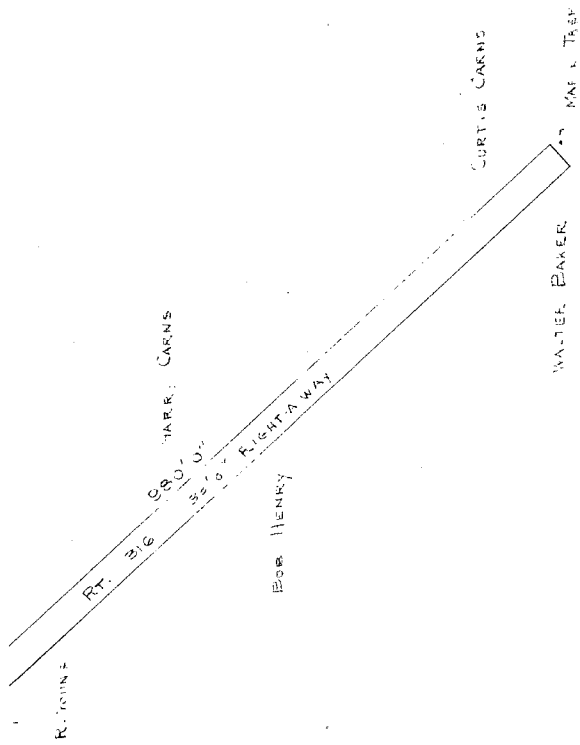
