Notice is hereby given by the Board of Supervisors of the Road District of the Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, of the passage of an Ordinance establishing and opening the following described public road as a part of the general road system of the Township of Goshen:

Beginning at the intersection of private road and State Highway Route No. 17126, at what is generally known as the Cramer Place, in the Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania; thence extending in a northerly direction along the course of said private road over lands of Jesse Taylor 200 feet to a stake; thence following the course of said private road over lands of Jesse Taylor in a northeasterly direction 300 feet to a stake; thence still following the course of said private road over lands of Jesse Taylor in a northerly direction 450 feet to a stake; thence still following the course of said private road in a northeasterly direction over lands of Jesse Taylor 425 feet to a stake; thence following the course of said private road in a northwesterly direction over lands of Jesse Taylor 125 feet to a stake at property line of Wilbur C. Hubler; thence deviating from the course of said private road and extending over lands of Wilbur C. Hubler in a northerly direction 260 feet to a stake; thence extending over lands of Wilbur C. Hubler in a northeasterly direction 460 feet to a stake at private road; thence following the course of said private road over lands of Wilbur C. Hubler in a northeasterly direction 325 feet to a stake; thence following the course of said private road in a northerly direction over lands of Wilbur C. Hubler and Chester Shugarts 400 feet to a stake; thence deviating from the course of said private road and extending in a northwesterly direction over lands of Chester Shugarts 322 feet and ending at a stake in a private road at or near the dwelling house of the said Chester Shugarts; said proposed road being 3,267 feet in length and 33 feet in width.

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND OPENING A PUBLIC ROAD IN THE  
TOWNSHIP OF GOSHEN, COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD AND  
STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained  
by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Goshen, County of  
Clearfield and State of Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. A Township Road is hereby established and  
opened and made a part of the general road system of the Township  
of Goshen.

Beginning at the intersection of private road and State  
Highway Route No. 17126, at what is generally known as  
the Cramer Place, in the Township of Goshen, Clearfield  
County, Pennsylvania; thence extending in a northerly  
direction along the course of said private road over  
lands of Jesse Taylor 200 feet to a stake; thence fol-  
lowing the course of said private road over lands of  
Jesse Taylor in a northeasterly direction 300 feet to  
a stake; thence still following the course of said pri-  
vate road over lands of Jesse Taylor in a northerly  
direction 450 feet to a stake; thence still following  
the course of said private road in a northeasterly  
direction over lands of Jesse Taylor 425 feet to a  
stake; thence following the course of said private road  
in a northwesterly direction over lands of Jesse Taylor  
125 feet to a stake at property line of Wilbur C. Hubler;  
thence deviating from the course of said private road  
and extending over lands of Wilbur C. Hubler in a north-  
erly direction 260 feet to a stake; thence extending  
over lands of Wilbur C. Hubler in a northeasterly direc-  
tion 460 feet to a stake at private road; thence fol-  
lowing the course of said private road over lands of  
Wilbur C. Hubler in a northeasterly direction 325 feet  
to a stake; thence following the course of said private  
road in a northerly direction over lands of Wilbur C.  
Hubler and Chester Shugarts 400 feet to a stake; thence  
deviating from the course of said private road and ex-  
tending in a northwesterly direction over lands of  
Chester Shugarts 322 feet and ending at a stake in a  
private road at or near the dwelling house of the said  
Chester Shugarts; said proposed road being 3,267 feet  
in length and 33 feet in width.

REPORT OF BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE  
ROAD DISTRICT OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
GOSHEN, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

TO THE HONORABLE JOHN J. PENTZ, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

We, the undersigned duly elected and qualified Supervisors of the Road District of the Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, upon the Petition of the property owners effected and other parties in interest requesting that the Supervisors of Goshen Township take over as a part of the general road system of the Township of Goshen, a private road long since in existence and used by the general public, the said road being hereinafter more specifically described, and in conformity with the provisions of the Act of Assembly of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, Art. XI, Section 1101, as amended, (P.S. 53, Section 1101 and 1102) in such case made and provided, do hereby make a report as follows:

(1). That your undersigned Board of Supervisors of the Road District of the Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the provisions of the Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, Art. XI, Section 1102, as last amended by Act of 1953, P.L. 511, Section 1102 (a) (53 P.S. 19093-1102) (a), gave ten days' written notice to the property owners effected thereby, namely; Wilbur C. Hubler and Pearl H. Hubler, his wife, Jesse Taylor and Ann L. Taylor, his wife, Chester Shugarts and the Trout Run Rod and Gun Club, that a meeting or hearing would be held at the Law Offices of A. B. Shaw, Esq., situate at 203 Market Street, Clearfield, Pennsylvania, on Saturday, the 20th day of February A. D., 1954, at 10:00 o'clock A.M. for the purpose of determining the

advisability and necessity of taking over said proposed road as a part of the general road system of the Township of Goshen, a copy of said notice being hereto attached and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A".

(2). That pursuant to said notice a meeting was held at the Law Offices of A. B. Shaw, Esq., Solicitor for Goshen Township Road District, on Saturday, February 20, 1954 at 10:00 o'clock A.M. when the following appearances were noted: A. B. Shaw, Esq., Solicitor for Goshen Township Road District, Glen Amon, George Read, Supervisors of Goshen Township, Chester Shugarts, William C. Hubler and Pearl H. Hubler, Petitioners and parties in interest, all of whom were sworn and examined by counsel and your Board. There being no objections to said proposed road, the meeting was adjourned for the purpose of obtaining an accurate survey or description covering certain necessary changes or deviations from the existing private road which the Petitioners or parties in interest requested the undersigned Board of Supervisors to take over as part of the general road system of the Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(3). That said proposed road lies wholly within the Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and for the most part extends over a private road which has long since been in existence, the same being described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of private road and State Highway Route No. 17126, at what is generally known as the Cramer Place, in the Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania; thence extending in a northerly direction along the course of said private road over lands of Jesse Taylor 200 feet to a stake; thence following the course of said private road over lands of Jesse Taylor in a northeasterly direction 300 feet to a stake; thence still following the course of said private road over lands of Jesse Taylor in a northerly direction 450 feet to a stake; thence still following the course of said private road in a northeasterly direction over lands of Jesse Taylor 425 feet to a stake; thence

following the course of said private road in a northwesterly direction over lands of Jesse Taylor 125 feet to a stake at property line of Wilbur C. Hubler; thence deviating from the course of said private road and extending over lands of Wilbur C. Hubler in a northerly direction 260 feet to a stake; thence extending over lands of Wilbur C. Hubler in a northeasterly direction 460 feet to a stake at private road; thence following the course of said private road over lands of Wilbur C. Hubler in a northeasterly direction 325 feet to a stake; thence following the course of said private road in a northerly direction over lands of Wilbur C. Hubler and Chester Shugarts 400 feet to a stake; thence deviating from the course of said private road and extending in a northwesterly direction over lands of Chester Shugarts 322 feet and ending at a stake in a private road at or near the dwelling house of the said Chester Shugarts; said proposed road being 3,267 feet in length and 33 feet in width.

(4). That your undersigned Board of Supervisors, after hearing on said Petition and further investigation made of this matter and said Board being of the opinion that said proposed road is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the traveling public, by virtue of the powers vested in them under the aforementioned acts of assembly, by resolution of your undersigned Board of Supervisors or a majority of them duly adopted at a special meeting held on the 12th day of November, 1954, passed an Ordinance for the laying out, opening and taking over of the aforementioned proposed road, as part of the general road system of the Township of Goshen, a copy of said Ordinance being hereto attached and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "B". Also attached and made a part hereof is a copy of the hand bills posted at conspicuous places along said proposed road within 10 days <sup>after</sup> the passage of said Ordinance as required by law, marked Exhibit "C".

(5). That attached hereto and made a part hereof is a draft or survey of said proposed road that has been passed and accepted by resolution ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> Ordinance, duly adopted by your undersigned Supervisors of Goshen Township as part of the general road system of said Township, showing the location of said proposed road, its over all length to be 3,267 feet and the width 33

feet as authorized by law, the fixed termini thereof and the property owners effected thereby.

(6). That attached hereto and made a part hereof is the Petition presented to your undersigned Supervisors of Goshen Township, requesting that the above described road be taken over as part of the general road system of the Township of Goshen; together with releases obtained from the owners or abutting property owners of the land through which said proposed road will pass, as shown by the accompanying blue print or sketch of said proposed road hereto attached.

WHEREFORE, your undersigned Board of Supervisors of the road district of the Township of Goshen respectfully request your Honorable Court to confirm this report *ni si* and that confirmation thereof be made absolute by the Clerk of the Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, as of course, unless exceptions are filed to this report within 30 days from the *ni si* confirmation thereof, as authorized by law.
